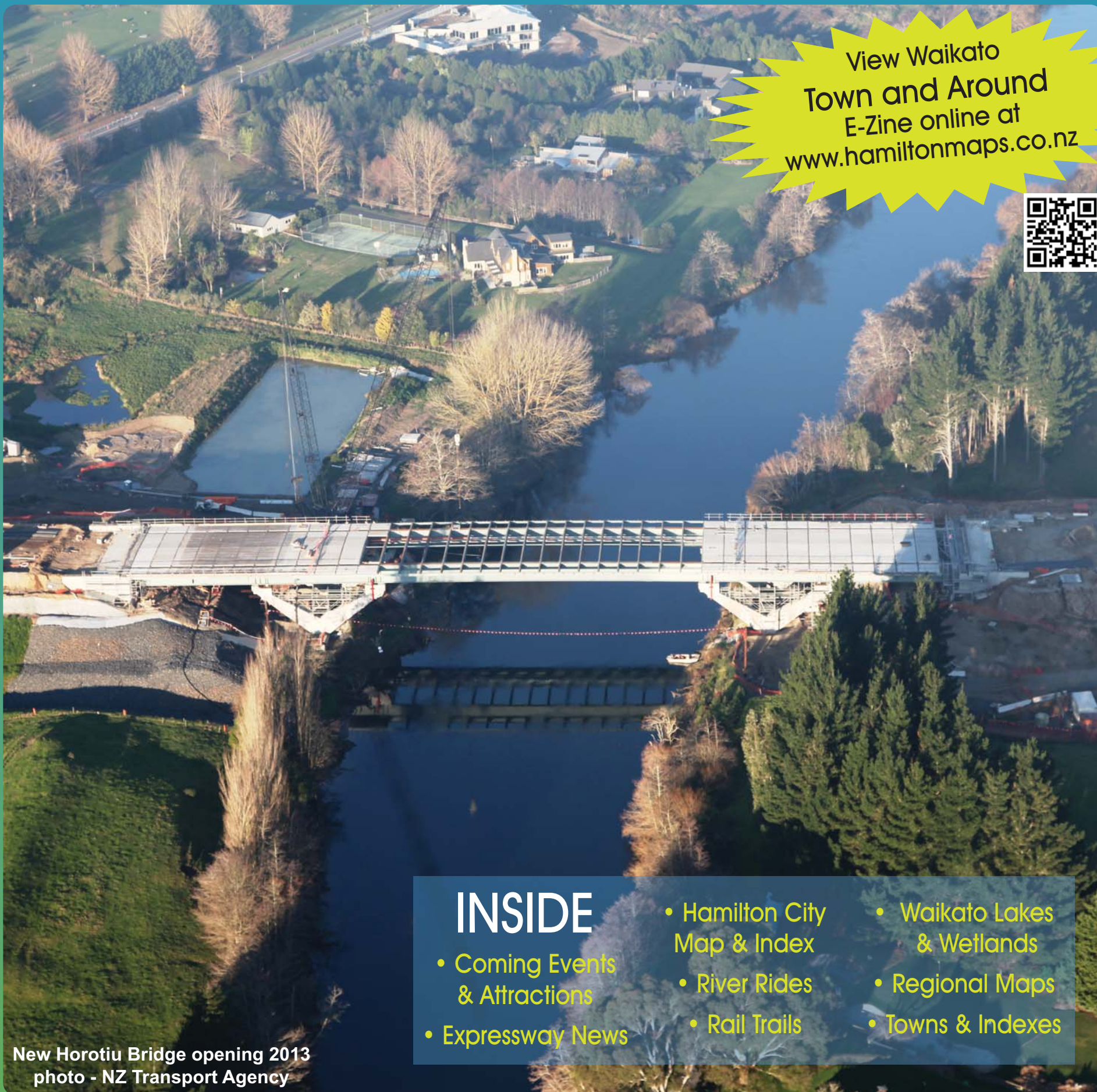

# Waikato Expressway



## THE HOROTIU BRIDGE

The 140-metre-long new **Horotiu Bridge** which will be finished in late 2013, is a key feature of the \$250 million Ngaruawahia section of the Waikato expressway. It will move traffic via the Taupiri/Gordonton interchange and southwards over the Waikato River via the Te Rapa highway and Avalon expressway. **Te Awa** - the shared river cycleway and walkway will link the Ngaruawahia section of the 70km track to Hamilton.

**Ngaruawahia** section of 12.3km is now in the construction phase, construction to complete late 2013.

**Te Rapa** section of 8km was completed in December 2012.

**Hamilton** section of 21.8km is now being investigated and designed.

The New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) has recently completed the upgrade of a section of SH1B (Gordonton Road) from Taupiri to the new Gordonton Road interchange. Signs will direct SH1 traffic to the new interchange, where an exit on the left hand side will bring southbound traffic onto

the Expressway via a new link road. The link road has been constructed so that south-bound traffic does not have to negotiate two roundabouts to get onto the Expressway. While the link is temporary, when the Huntly Section of the Expressway is completed the link Road will be removed.

**Pokeno & Mercer** sections totalling 22.6km are completed.

**Longswamp** section of 5.9km is in the investigation and design stage. The Longswamp section of the Waikato Expressway links the already completed Mercer Section (just



south of the Hampton Downs Interchange) to the Rangiriri Section to the south.

**Rangiriri** section totalling 4.8km is under construction. It runs south joining the existing highway south of Rangiriri.

**Ohinewai** section of 7.0km is completed.

**Huntly** section of 15.2km is now in secondary investigation and specimen design. From **Ohinewai** to **Taupiri**, the projected expressway will run through countryside behind Taupiri Mountain and join at the Taupiri intersection to the Gordonton/Hamilton section.

**Tamahere** interchange of 2.4km is completed.

**Cambridge** section of 16km is expected to begin in late 2013.

## WAIKATO WETLANDS & PEAT LAKES

Works have continued in the **Lake Areare** wetland. The creation of this 8000m<sup>2</sup> wetland adjacent to the lake included minor works at Ormsby Rd, the establishment of two connected water retention areas, and an access track for maintenance and the planting of nearly 40,000 plants.

**Lake D (Lake Kainui)** is situated on Lake Rd north of Hamilton and administered by the Waikato District Council. (1 hour circuit).

**Lake B (Lake Kaituna)**, also off Lake Road, is being progressively cleared of willows and replanted with native plants and walkways are being developed through community effort. Access is via private land.

**Waiwhakareke Reserve** just out of Hamilton is 60 hectares, being restored back to wetland by volunteer labour.

**Lake Rotokauri northwest of Hamilton** is a peat lake, a conservation and wildlife reserve with a well developed walkway.

**Lake Cameron** is a small lake at Rukuhia south of Hamilton. Access to the lake edge is available off Rukuhia Rd.

Foot access to the **Lake Rotomanuka Reserve** follows the fence line opposite Ryburn Rd on SH3 at Ohaupo.

**Lake Rotopataka Reserve** - fenced foot access leads to the lake from Thompson Rd.

**Lake Ruatuna Reserve** - This wildlife management reserve is accessed off Forkett Rd, Ohaupo. There is a recreation reserve which includes a youth camp and picnic area on the western side of the lake. Foot access is available through the recreation reserve to the lake.

**Lake Serpentine Reserve** can be accessed directly from State Highway 3 south



of Hamilton. There is a mown walkway around the east lake and a newly erected predator-proof fence.

**Lake Ngaroto** is one of the largest peat lakes in the Waikato. Access is via Bank Road to a picnic area by the yacht and rowing clubs. 2 hrs to walk a circular track.

### Some Rules when visiting these Reserves:

Take only photos and leave only footprints. Waterfowl hunting and freshwater fishing in New Zealand requires a licence, contact Fish and Game New Zealand.

Ask permission before entering or crossing private land.

Keep to formed paths.

Collecting native plants, and taking or releasing wildlife requires a permit from the Department of Conservation.

To minimise spread of weed and disease, thoroughly clean boats, fishing gear, and boots between wetlands.

Please take care with fire, and smoke only in designated areas.

Leaving your dog at home, or keep it on a leash (unless using it for licensed hunting).

Enjoy our wetlands and their inhabitants.

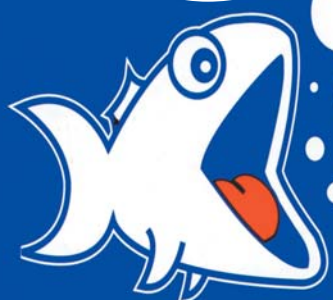

The tracks all have a variety of travel choices and variety of grades. Tickets are available for purchase each Sunday while the Railway is open. Tickets do not expire and can be used any week-end. A single fare is \$2. All funds raised are utilised on the Railway and facilities.

From Forest Lake Rd turn into Walsh Ave. Turn left into Kiwi Ave, and finally right into Tui Ave. Situated in the middle of Minogue Park, entrance at the very end of Tui Avenue, and drive down the park access road.

Currently Hamilton Model Engineers has a membership of close to 70 people, from children to adults, and from as far afield as Christchurch. Although there is a central interest of the Miniature Railway, the members have a diverse range of Modelling and Engineering interests. Real steam boats, Steam trains, Garden Railways, R/C Aircraft and stationary engines are just some of the interests.

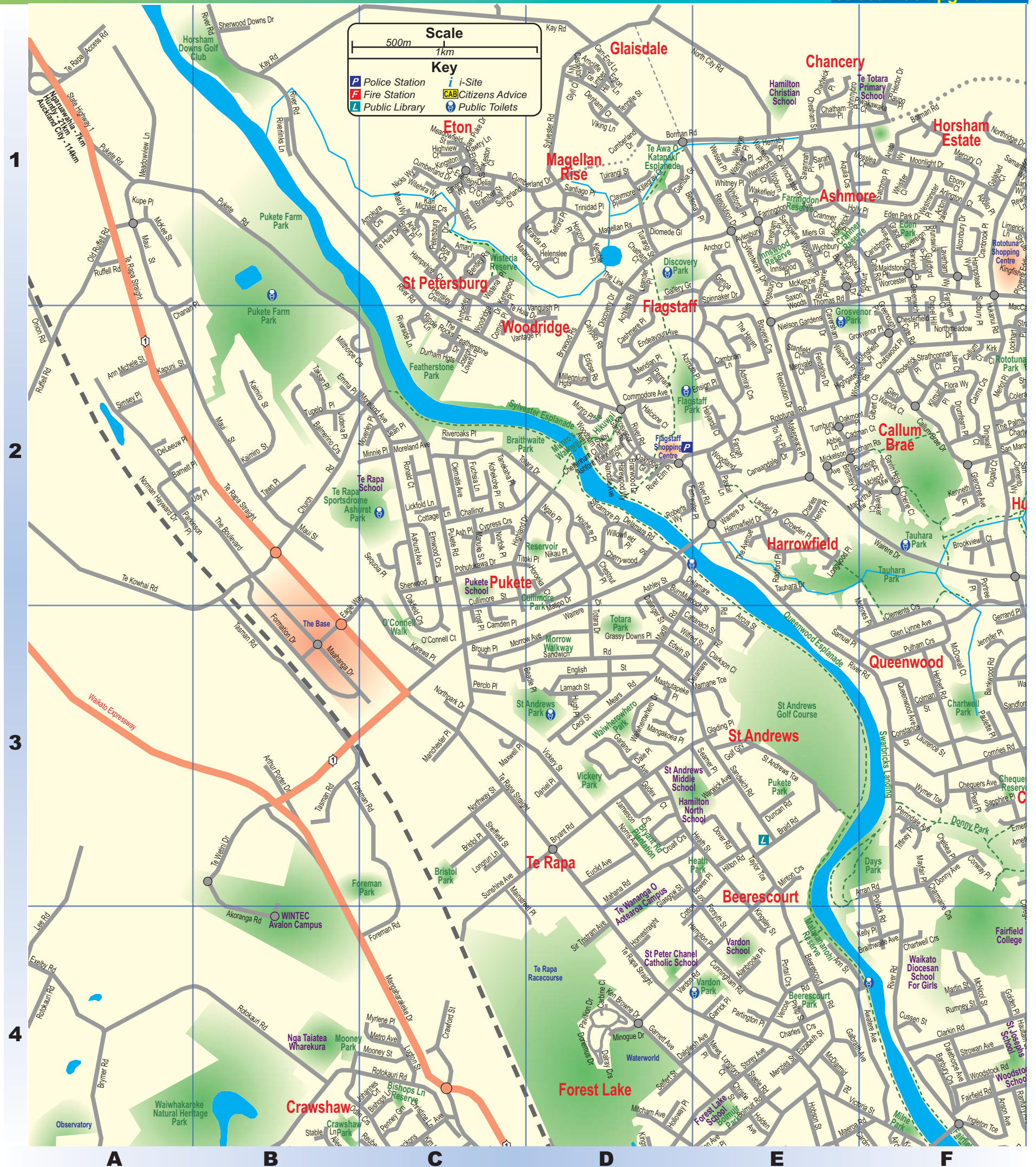

## New Borders for Waikato Region

The Waikato Region borders have been extended northwards to include the towns of Port Waikato, Pokeno and Tuakau. State Highway 1 runs down through this area and is in the process of being upgraded to the Waikato Expressway, known as the Longwamp section which will join up at Taupiri to the Gordonton/Ngaruawahia/Hamilton section. The Expressway will bypass Huntly and will be completed in 2016 and will make the journey to and from Auckland considerably faster.

The area was important historically during the Waikato Wars, as the colonialists pushed down into the Waikato. Along the highway are historic sites for both sides, redoubts and Pa sites, the most famous being the Rangiriri Pa site where the final stand of Maori and Pakeha soldiers was fought out.

At Rangiriri the casualties of this engagement are buried in the small cemetery. Many of the historical sites are signposted and can be accessed from the main highway. The Te Araroa Walkway (the Long Pathway - part of a New Zealand long walkway) runs through the Mercer to Rangiriri section. The Whangamarino Walkway can be accessed from Oram Road at Meremere, the northern ends starts at Mercer and ends at Huntly.

Work is being done along the Waikato River through the Whangamarino wetlands by the Waikato Rivercare Restoration Project, including planting of native species. Port Waikato is a delightful beach popular for surfing and is the only rivermouth delta with a sand bar in the Southern Hemisphere. From Port Waikato drive southward through Limestone Downs, a rugged scenic trip that passes by the Nikau cave.



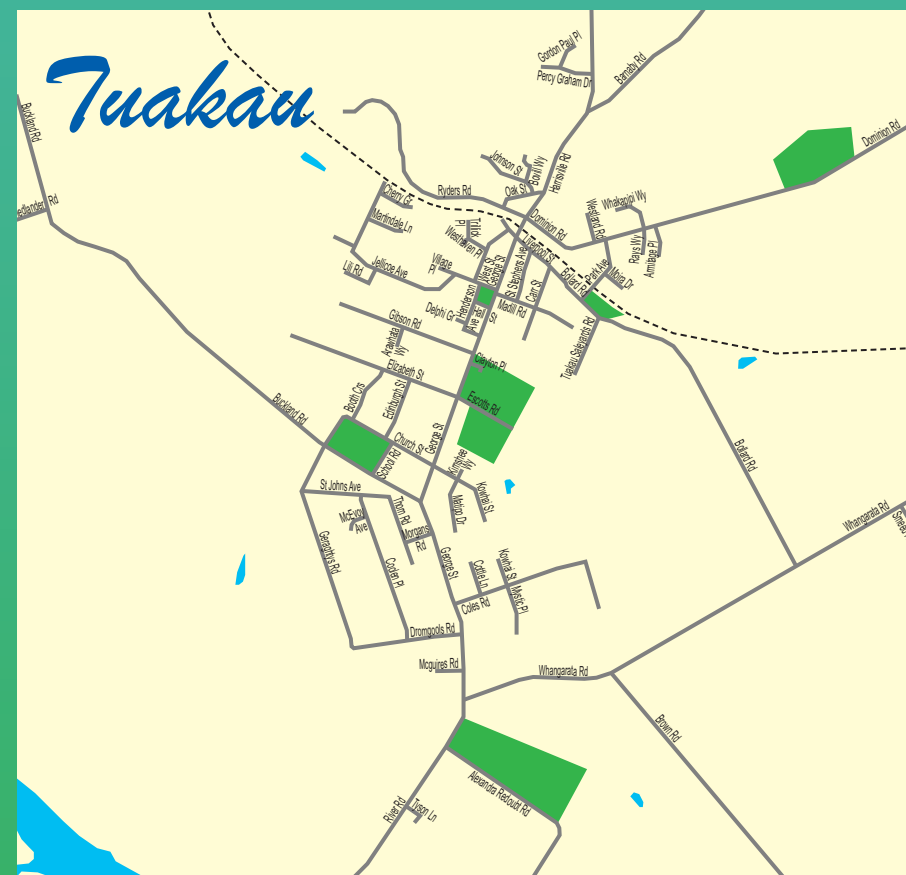

# Te Aroha

## Historic Spa Town

Piako District



Te Aroha is a town with many historic associations, and this shows in its charming architectural buildings. One of the highlights is the 29 acre landscaped Edwardian style Domain which houses the Te Aroha Mineral Spas - private, indoor hot tubs filled with naturally hot soda water and the world's only hot soda fountain - the Mokena Geyser. Wander through the historic Cadman House Museum - New Zealand's original sanatorium. The Domain is also home to the Te Aroha Leisure pools complex - public, outdoor, heated pools, including outdoor spa, designed for a diverse range of visitors. Start the day with a picnic in the Domain, and then proceed with one of the many bush-walks, including a track from the park up the mountain or some mountain biking - there is a huge network of walking and mountain bike tracks in the Kaimai-Mamaku Forest Park. A 100-year-old track starting near the bottom of Mt Te Aroha leads to Tutumangao Waterfall. Follow the Heritage Trail of fine historic buildings

and monuments dating back to the early 1880s. The Waiorongomai Valley is a significant gold mining site in the Kaimai-Mamaku Forest Park. The valley offers numerous walks following old mining trails. A prospector, Hone Werahiko found gold in the Waiorongomai Valley in 1881. The Piako County Tramway was built in 1882-83 and is New Zealand's oldest known railway with the original rail still in place, a showcase historic site for the Department of Conservation. There are a number of historic areas to explore in the valley, such as Hardy's Hut, Fern Spur incline and winding gear, the Bendigo Battery, the Low Level Drive, and the May Queen Incline and winding gear. The Waiorongomai Valley lies at the end of Waiorongomai Loop Road. The Valley is just four kilometres south of Te Aroha, near State Highway 26.

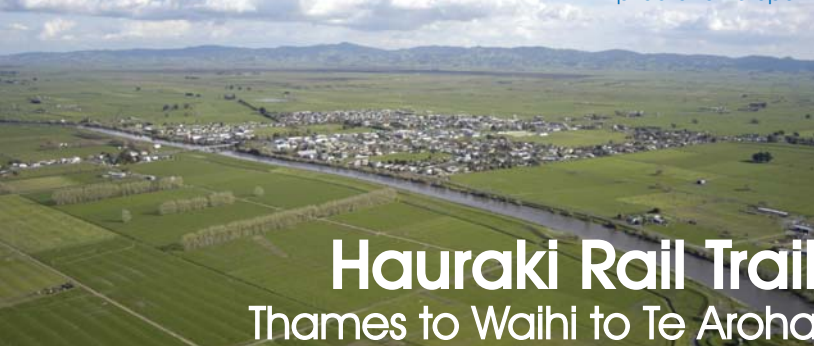

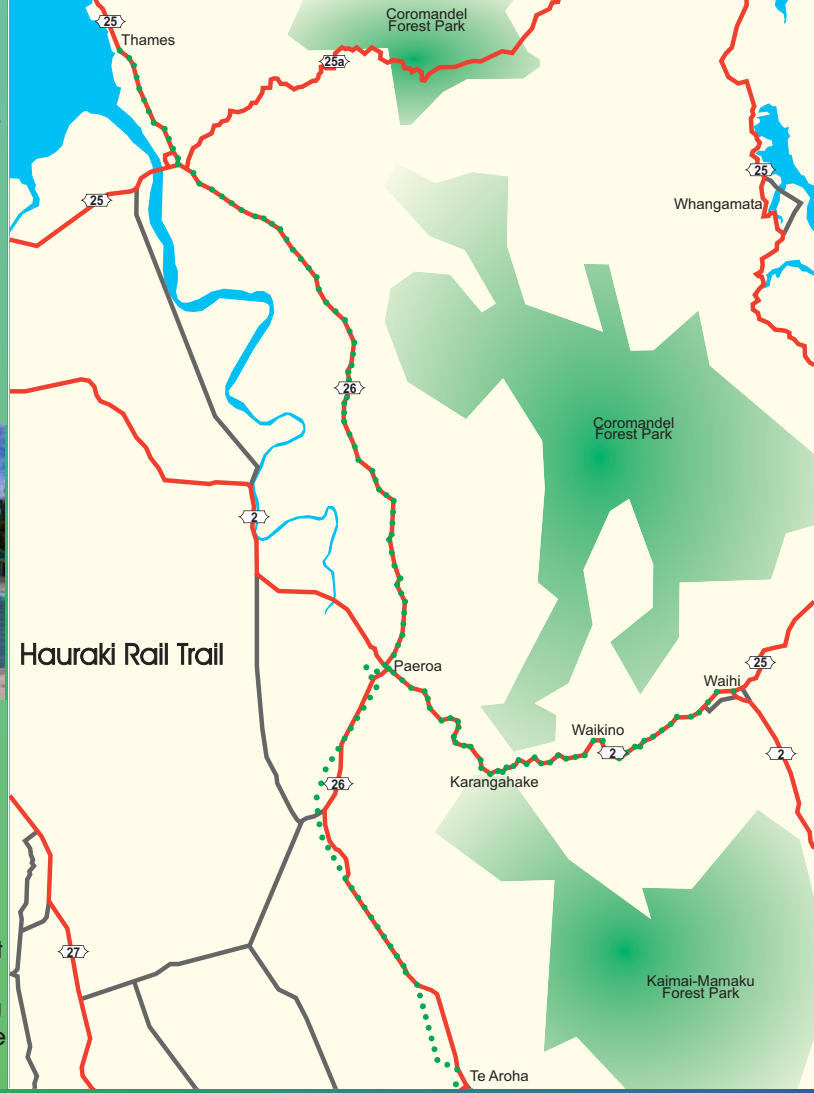

There are shorter day riding options. The trail shows some of the best scenery in New Zealand through areas rich in pioneering history. A major highlight includes riding through the scenic Karangahake Gorge, on the Waihi stretch. The Hauraki Rail Trail is shown as the dotted line on map below.



Ngatea is the main service centre on the Hauraki Plains, located on SHW 2, and within an hours drive of Auckland. Nestled on the banks of the Piako River, Ngatea has an array of shops and eating establishments on offer, the picturesque water gardens to visit, and the newly developed Pioneer Park.

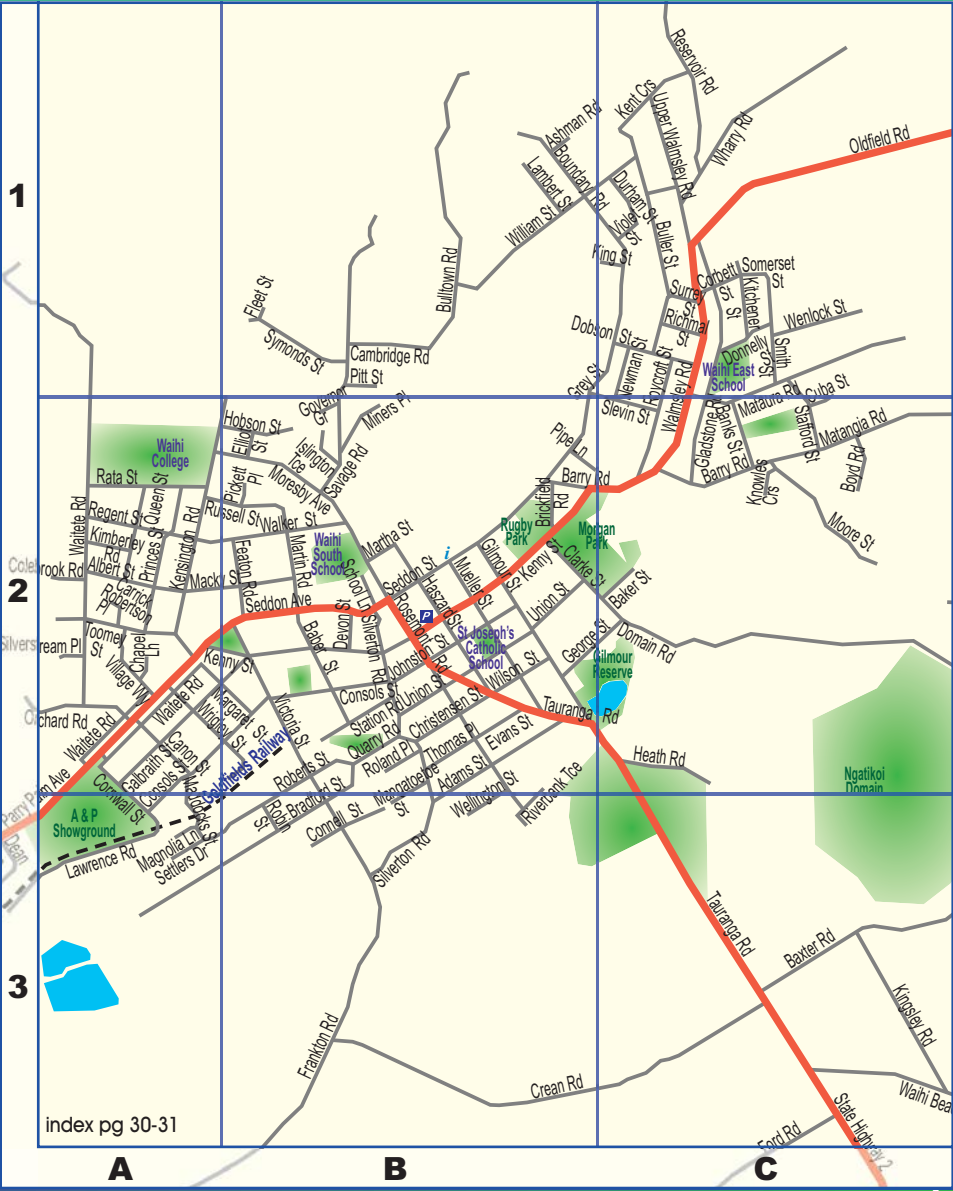

Paeroa is "World Famous in New Zealand" and overseas – for its Big Bottle. At 7 metres high, the Lemon and Paeroa Bottle is a permanent reminder of the therapeutic Paeroa Springs Water discovered before 1900, which, with the addition of lemon, became known as New Zealand's own soft drink.

Originally a thriving river port, the town was first laid out in the 1870s and the Historic Maritime Park and Museum houses artifacts from this era. Paeroa is also known for the many antique, second hand and retro shops where you can spend hours fossicking. The site of the original gold rush in 1875, Karangahake and its "residential suburb" of Mackaytown, have returned to peaceful activities; fishing, gardens, cafes and a winery. In Karangahake, one can access the 1km long railway tunnel and the Windows Walk and follow the Ohinemuri River through to Waikino. Good swimming and picnicking sites are easily accessed. Walking tracks lead into the Kaimai-Mamaku and Coromandel Forest Parks.

Waihi's story is a rich tapestry woven through with golden thread. You can walk right to the edge of Waihi's huge open pit gold mine. Waihi Goldmine Tours conducts daily tours of the site, (bookings are essential). Local shops combine old style service with an eclectic range of goods, cafes and restaurants. Local walkways include the Pit Rim Walkway, also to the top of Black Hill and from Gilmour Lake a track follows Mill Stream around the base of Union Hill, another historic mining area.

Karangahake Gorge is a historic gold mining area with spectacular scenery, swing bridges across the Ohinemuri and Waitawheta Rivers, old mining tunnels (bring a torch and sturdy footwear), bush walks. Take a scenic train trip with Goldfields Railway to Waikino to view old mining remains. Part of the Hauraki Rail Trail winds through the Karangahake Scenic Reserve and Conservation area.

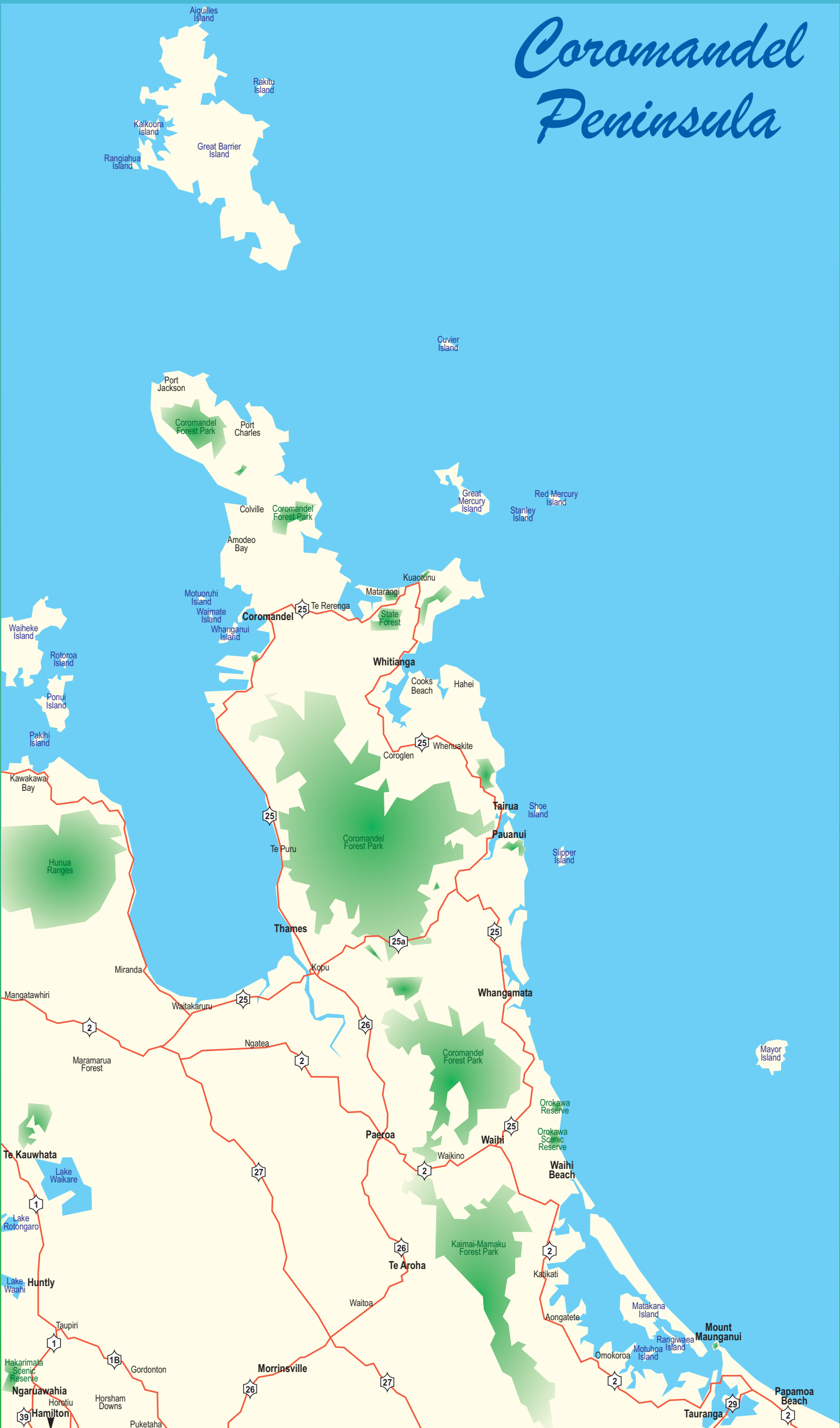

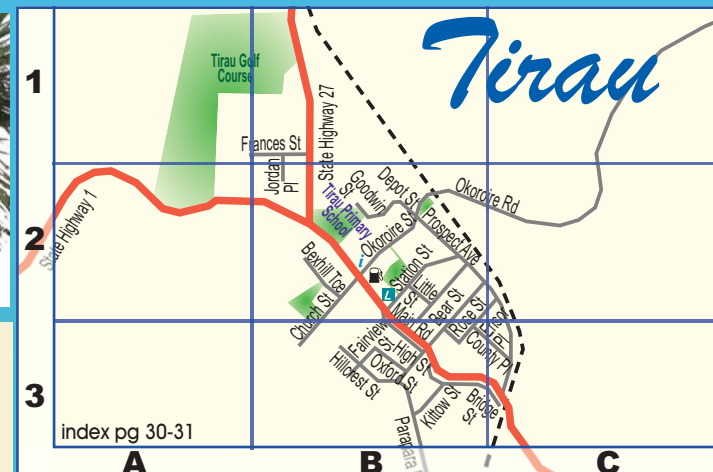

### Farming & Timber South Waikato District

Putaruru has a variety of walks - long or short. Visitors to Putaruru are invited to wander **Te Waihou Walkway** to view the **Blue Springs**. The crystal clear spring water is bottled in town, and sold commercially, nationally and beyond, as "Pump" water. Putaruru is based on a history of farming and timber and has the Lichfield Dairy Factory - which is one of the newest and largest cheese factories in the world. Visit the Putaruru Timber Museum to learn about the history of timber milling. In even years, the District holds its Spring Into Summer Festival with a wide range of community activities, sporting and cultural

events for the three-week festival. The blue colours of the **Putaruru Waterpark** mimic the colours of Te Waihou spring. Around 5000 plants - all natives - are planted on site. The shape of the feature is similar to the curve of a ponga fern shoot. The Waterpark also features two large mosaics. The **Lorraine Moller Arboretum** is on the outskirts of Putaruru accessed from Harry Martin Drive. It is an impressive collection of exotic trees. Enter the gate and follow the wheel-chair accessible path to the lookout or descend to the valley floor through the labelled collection of maple, oak and dogwood.

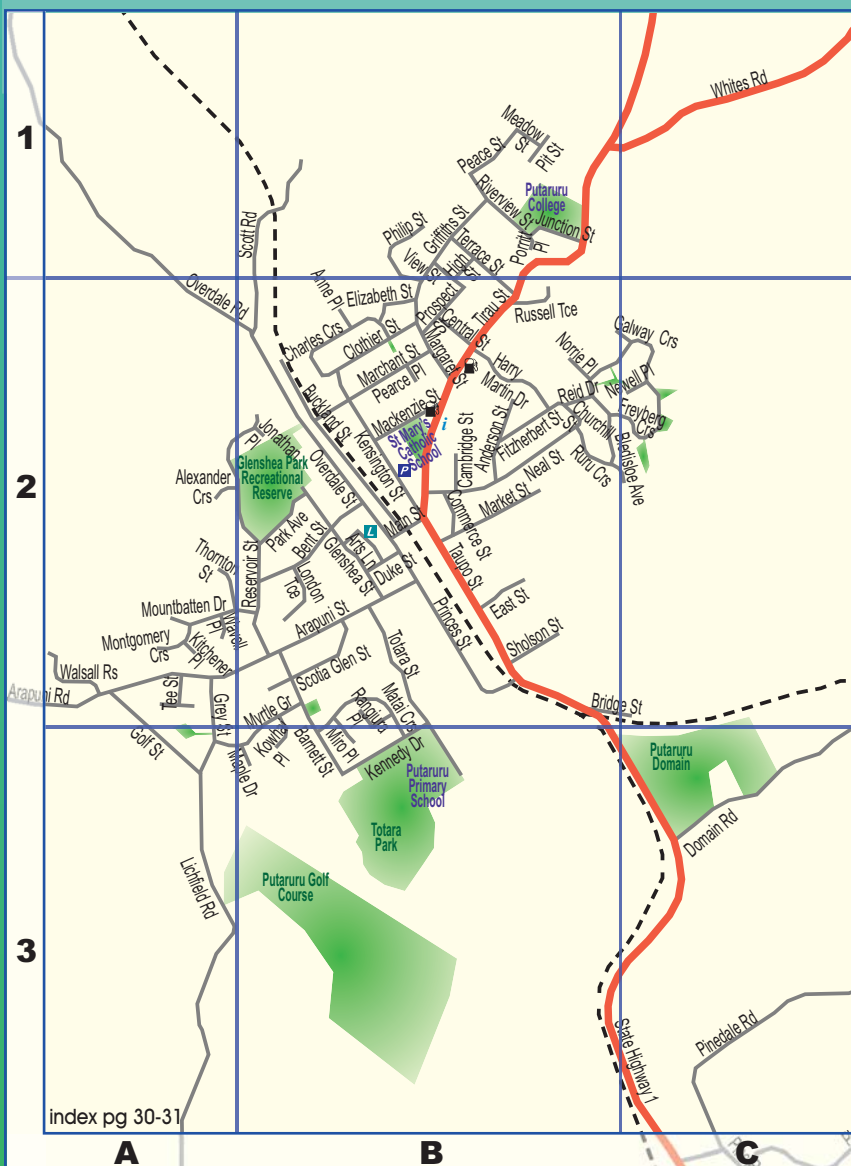
A major millennium project saw the formation of a 5 kilometre walkway along the upper reaches of the **Waihou River** providing access to view the **famous Blue Spring**. The water from the Blue Spring is so clear it radiates a stunning ultramarine turquoise light. It is beautiful!

**Te Waiou-Arapuni Heritage Trail** is comprised of six sites - **Stone House**, **Te Waiou School**, **Jim Barnett Reserve**, **Jones Landing**, **Arapuni Hydro Station** and **Duxfield Reserve**. The **Arapuni Dam and Swing Bridge** are well worth the 15 minute drive, walk across the swing bridge and look down on the awesome swirling waters from the power station.

The best time to ride the trail is September to May. The Waikato has a temperate climate so all but the mid-winter months are ideal for riding. The trails are largely protected from the wind.

SH1 provides key access points to both ends of the trail. To the north, access is off SH1 onto Horahora Road, driving for 5km before reaching the Pokaiwhenua Bridge car park which is the starting point of the Karapiro Trail. And to the south, access is off SH1 onto Ongaroto Road (SH30); 50m from the turnoff brings you to the start of the Atiamuri Trail.

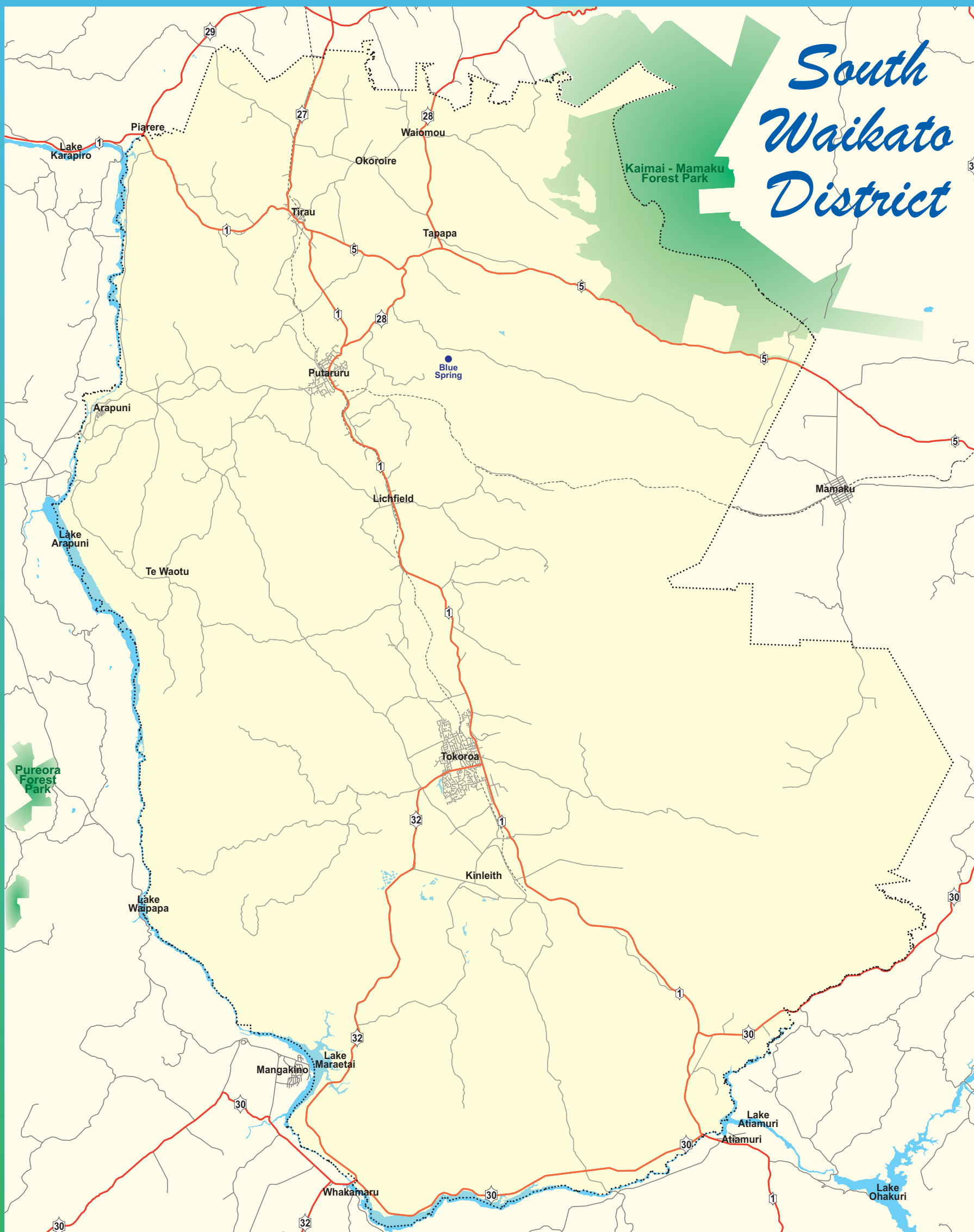

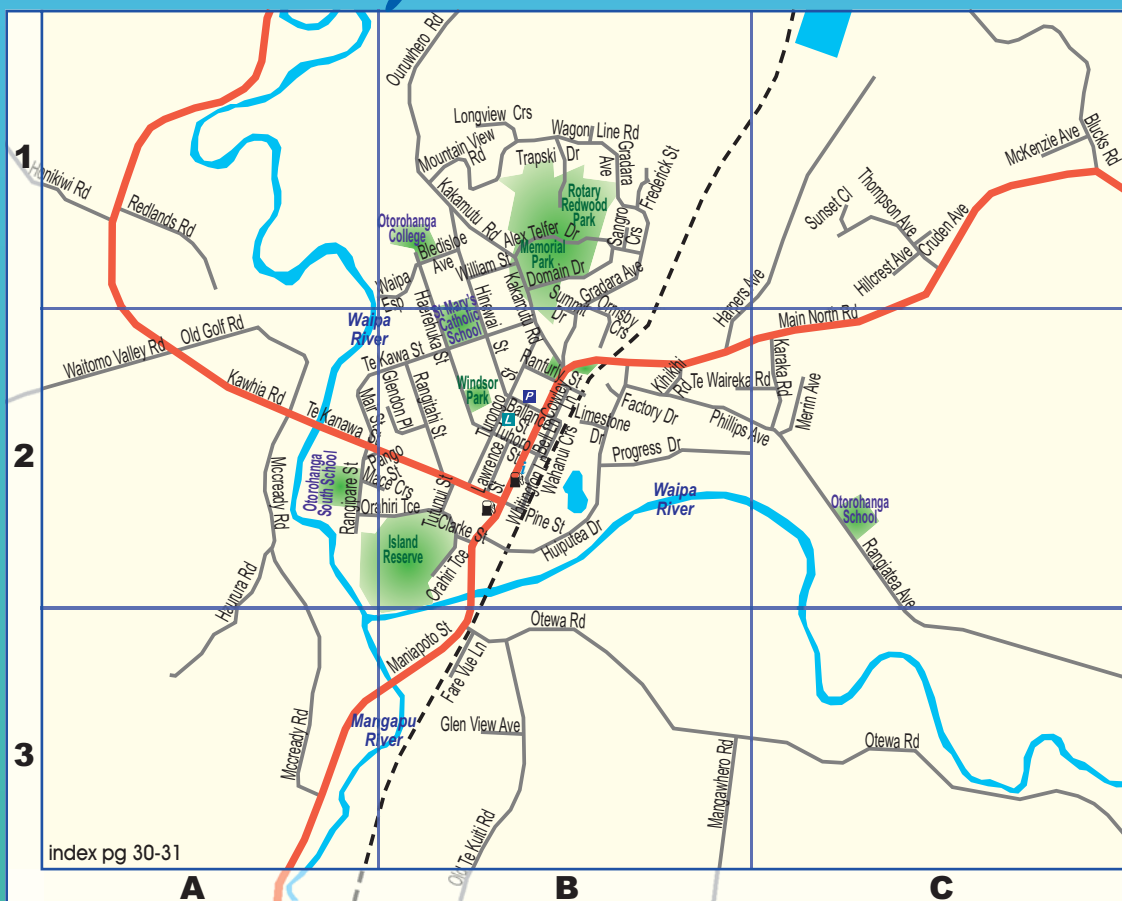

The Timber Trail passes through the Pureora Forest Park, where riders will pass through four ecological areas showcasing remnants of the great forests that once dominated the area. The trail traverses Mount Pureora then runs along the western side of the Hauhungaroa Range before dropping down to Ongarue.

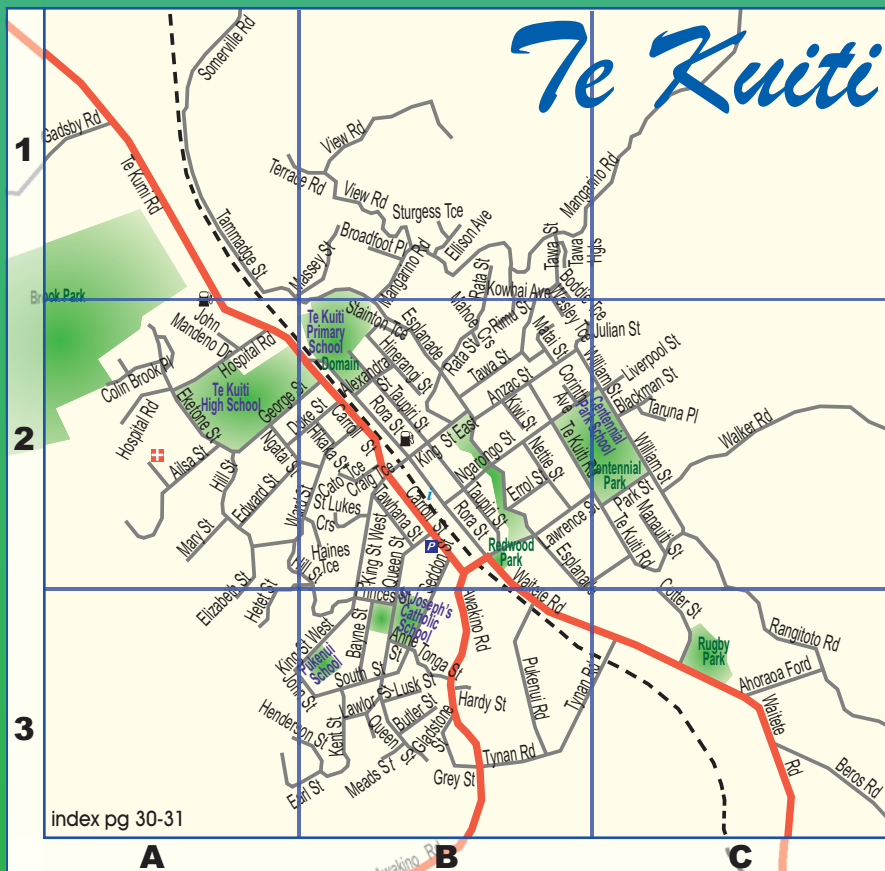
The nationally significant Ongarue Spiral is being lovingly restored to its former glory as part of the cycle trail's development. Some of New

Zealand's highest and longest suspension bridges will also be a feature of the trail. There are no food stores or petrol outlets at Pureora or Ongarue; the nearest facilities to Pureora are at Benneydale, 15 minutes west along SH30, or at Mangakino, 20 minutes east.

## WAITOMO WALKS

The self-guided privately run **Dundie Hill Walk** is a 27km, two-day/one-night loop walk through Waitomo's bush and farmland, including overnight bunk-house accommodation in the bush.

**The Mangaokewa Scenic Reserve** is a nice place to relax, go fishing or swimming. There are scenic walks as you travel south to **Ruakuri Reserve**, **Marokopa Waterfall** and **Mangapohue Natural Bridge**, **Piripiri Cave** and drive on to the coast to Marokopa beach for fishing and Kirithehere for fossil fossicking.

Te Kuiti township is the main service centre of the Waitomo District. Local industry includes everything from meat processing, timber mills and lime processing to rural support services.

Te Kuiti has long been recognised as New Zealand's sheep shearing capital and celebrates its rich agricultural heritage in style with the annual NZ Shearing Championships in March, together with the increasingly popular festival known as the "Great NZ Muster". Check out the new Pa Harakeke Eco Cultural Centre at 138 Maraeroa Rd, for a unique look into Maori traditions and culture.

There is an 18-hole golf course in Piopio, where sheep maintain the fairways! To the south-west is the picturesque Mokau surf beach.
