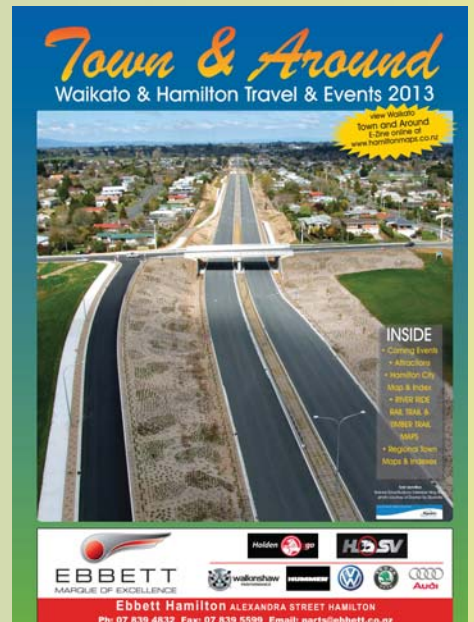

Hamilton's new Ringroads and Waikato Expressway

The Waikato Expressway and Hamilton Ring Roads

The Waikato region is undergoing major transportation changes with a massive new system of roads with under and overpasses. The Waikato Expressway project will improve safety and reliability and reduce travel times and congestion on SH1 by delivering a four-lane highway from the Bombay Hills to south of

Cambridge. The Expressway is will be built in eight sections. **Hamilton Ring Road Upgrade and Extension** - The Avalon Drive/Te Rapa/Horotiu section will open in 2012 to take the route directly north. Work is continuing on a new bridge across the Waikato River at Horotiu taking the Waikato Expressway through the countryside to the new Taupiri/SH1 roundabout.

The Wairere Drive 4-Laning (Pukete Rd to Pukete Bridge) project involves the widening of the 1.6km section of Wairere Drive to four lanes and a signalised intersection. A clip-on pedestrian and cyclist facility will be attached to the existing Pukete Bridge. These works are scheduled to be finished by early 2013.

The River Road Intersection Upgrade According to project specifications the River Rd intersection now sees approximately 35,000 vehicles per day travel through the roundabout and the functionality of a roundabout became a concern. The upgrade of this roundabout into a new signalised intersection is scheduled to be complete by December 2012.

Wairere Drive Extension from Crosby Rd Roundabout to Ruakura Rd completes another section of the Hamilton Ring Road, already open.

The Peachgrove Road/TeAroha Road Intersection and Ruakura Road Upgrade involves the construction of a new signalised intersection where Wairere Drive meets Ruakura Rd and 4-laning of Ruakura Rd. It was identified as a necessity due to Ruakura Rd being a key arterial route in the east of the city providing an important link from the city to Waikato University and the Hillcrest area. It will improve safety and help with traffic volumes.

The Tamahere/Cambridge section is known as the Southern Link. It will link with SH1 from Kahikatea Drive in Hamilton City to Tamahere and the Waikato Expressway in the south, and SH3 from Hamilton Airport to central and east Hamilton.

The Longswamp section of the Waikato Expressway links to the already completed Mercer Section. The Waikato Expressway will be the key strategic transport corridor for the Waikato region, connecting Auckland to the Waikato and Bay of Plenty.



The Great New Zealand River Ride

A new cycle track is being developed from Pukete to Horotiu, called Te Awa, running along the Waikato River. That will become part of Te Awa - The Great New Zealand River Ride which will be 70 kilometres long, beside the Waikato River. This is being developed in sections from Ngaruawahia through to Hamilton via Horotiu, completion due 2014, to Leamington in Cambridge completion due 2015, and to the Lake Karapiro Mighty River Domain section which is already complete.

Te Aroha is a town with many historic associations, and this shows in its charming architectural buildings. One of the highlights is the 29 acre landscaped Edwardian style Domain which houses the Te Aroha Mineral Spas - private, indoor hot tubs filled with naturally hot soda water and the world's only hot soda fountain - the Mokena Geyser. The Domain is also home to the Te Aroha Leisure pools complex - public, outdoor, heated pools, including outdoor spa, designed for a diverse range of visitors. Start the day with a picnic in the Domain, and then proceed with one of the many bushwalks, including a track from the park up the mountain

or some mountain biking - there is a huge network of walking and mountain bike tracks in the Kaimai-Mamaku Forest Park. Follow the Heritage Trail of fine historic buildings and monuments dating back to the early 1880s. Wander through the historic Cadman House Museum - New Zealand's original sanatorium and view the Queen Ann Pipe Organ built in 1712 (group performances are available) - the oldest pipe organ in the Southern Hemisphere.

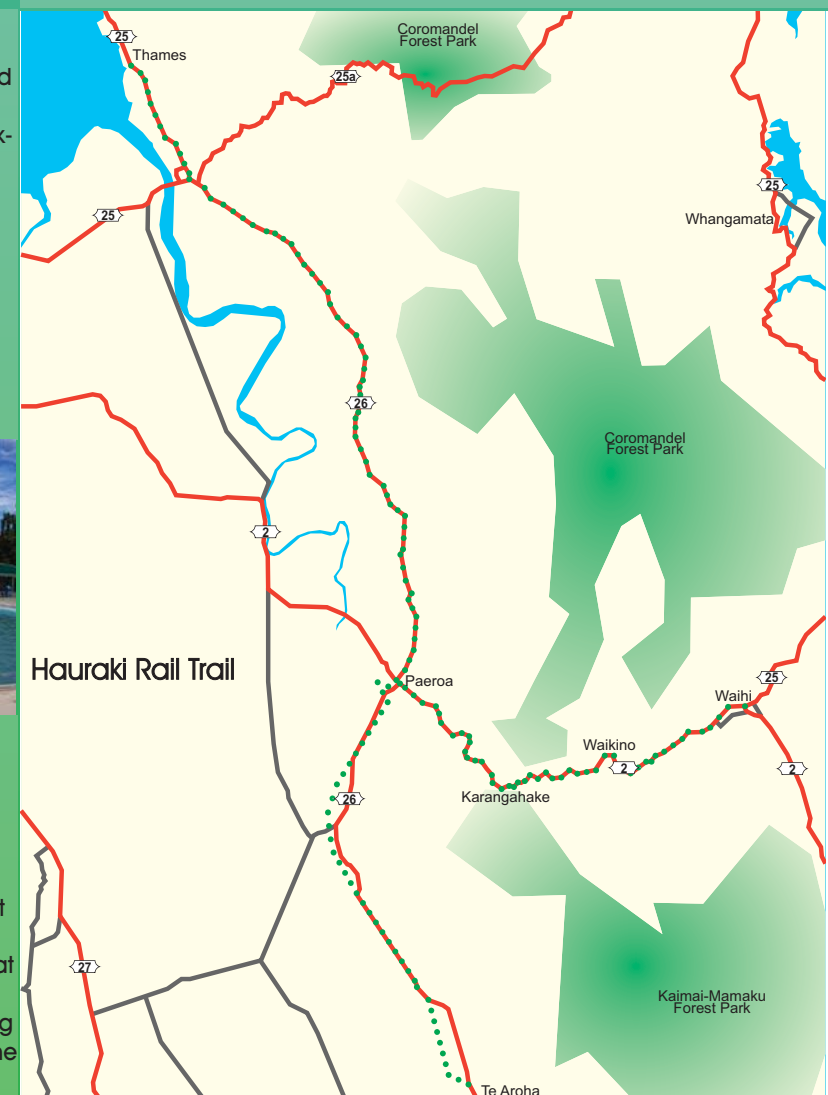

Originally a thriving port, the town was first laid out in the 1870's. Paeroa is "World Famous in New Zealand" and overseas – for its Big Bottle. At 7 metres high, the Lemon and Paeroa Bottle is a permanent reminder of the therapeutic Paeroa Springs Water discovered before 1900, which, with the addition of lemon, became known

as New Zealand's own soft drink. Originally a thriving river port, the town was first laid out in the 1870s and the Historic Maritime Park and Museum houses artifacts from this era. Paeroa is also known for the many antique, second hand and retro shops where you can spend hours fossicking.

The site of the original gold rush in 1875, Karangahake and its "residential suburb" of Mackaytown, have returned to peaceful activities; fishing, gardens, cafes and a winery. In Karangahake, one can access the 1km long railway tunnel and the Windows Walk and follow the Ohinemuri River through to Waikino. Good swimming and picnicking sites are easily accessed. Walking tracks lead into the Kaimai-Mamaku and Coromandel Forest Parks.

Waihi's story is a rich tapestry woven through with golden thread. Today, you can walk right to the edge of Waihi's huge open pit gold mine. Waihi Goldmine Tours conducts daily tours of the site, (bookings are essential). Local shops combine old style service with an eclectic range of goods and cafes and restaurants. Local walkways include the Pit Rim Walkway, also to the top of Black Hill and from Gilmour Lake a track follows Mill Stream around the base of Union Hill, another historic mining area.

Karangahake Gorge is a historic gold mining area with spectacular scenery, swing bridges across the Ohinemuri and Waitawheta Rivers, old mining tunnels (bring a torch and sturdy footwear), bush walks. Take a scenic train trip with Goldfields Railway to Waikino to view old mining remains. Part of the Hauraki Rail Trail winds through the Karangahake Scenic Reserve and Conservation area.

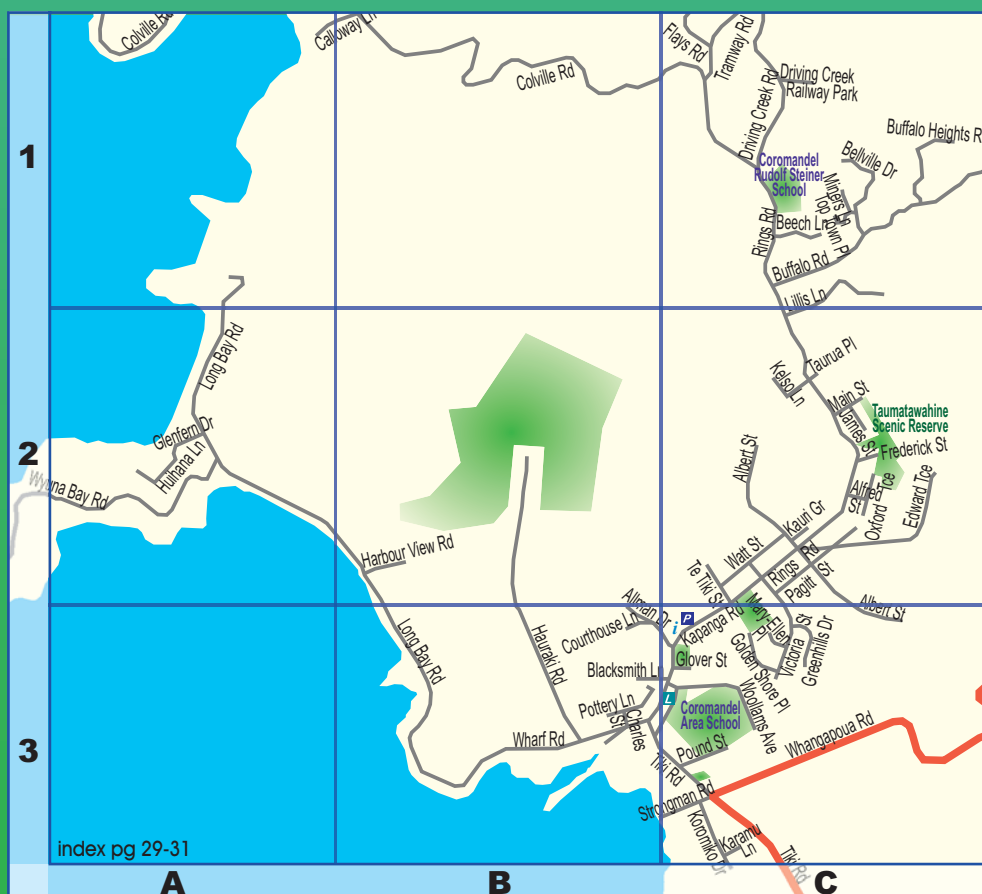

WALKS IN WHITIANGA

Cathedral Cove, Accessible only on foot or by boat, famous Cathedral Cove is one of the "must visit" sites on the Coromandel Peninsula

Cooks Monument, In 1769 Cook made landfall in New Zealand at a place south of what we know today as the Mercury Bay.

Ferry Landing to Shakespeare Cliff, This walk will take you through the historic cemetery at Ferry Landing and on past Front Beach and Flaxmill Bay before reaching Shakespeare Cliff.

Ferry Landing to Shakespeare Cliff via Maramaratotara Track, Cooks Beach, The first part of this walk takes you up Whitianga Rock, home to an interesting pa site. This area is covered in bush and has a lovely sheltered picnic spot.

Historic Whitianga Rock Maori Pa site

The walk begins at Ferry Landing Wharf, the oldest stone wharf in Australasia built in 1837, and continues on to the Maori Pa site and various other historical points of interest.

Hot Water Beach, Hot Water Beach is a truly unique Kiwi experience, digging in the sand for a hot water spot, take care with swimming though, the water can be unpredictable.

Broken Hills 19kms south of Tairua at Hikurangi is a turnoff to a Department of Conservation area called Broken Hills, part of the Puketui Valley.

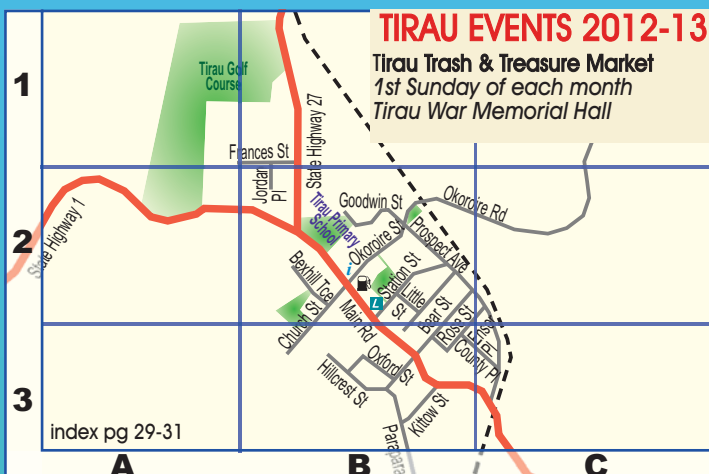

Putaruru has a variety of walks - long or short. Visitors to Putaruru are invited to wander **Te Waihou Walkway** to view the **Blue Springs**. The crystal clear spring water is bottled in town, and sold commercially, nationally and beyond, as "Pump" water.

Putaruru is based on a history of farming and timber and has the Lichfield Dairy Factory - which is one of the newest and largest cheese factories in the world. Visit the Putaruru Timber Museum to learn about the history of timber milling. In even years, the District holds its Spring Into Summer Festival with a wide range of

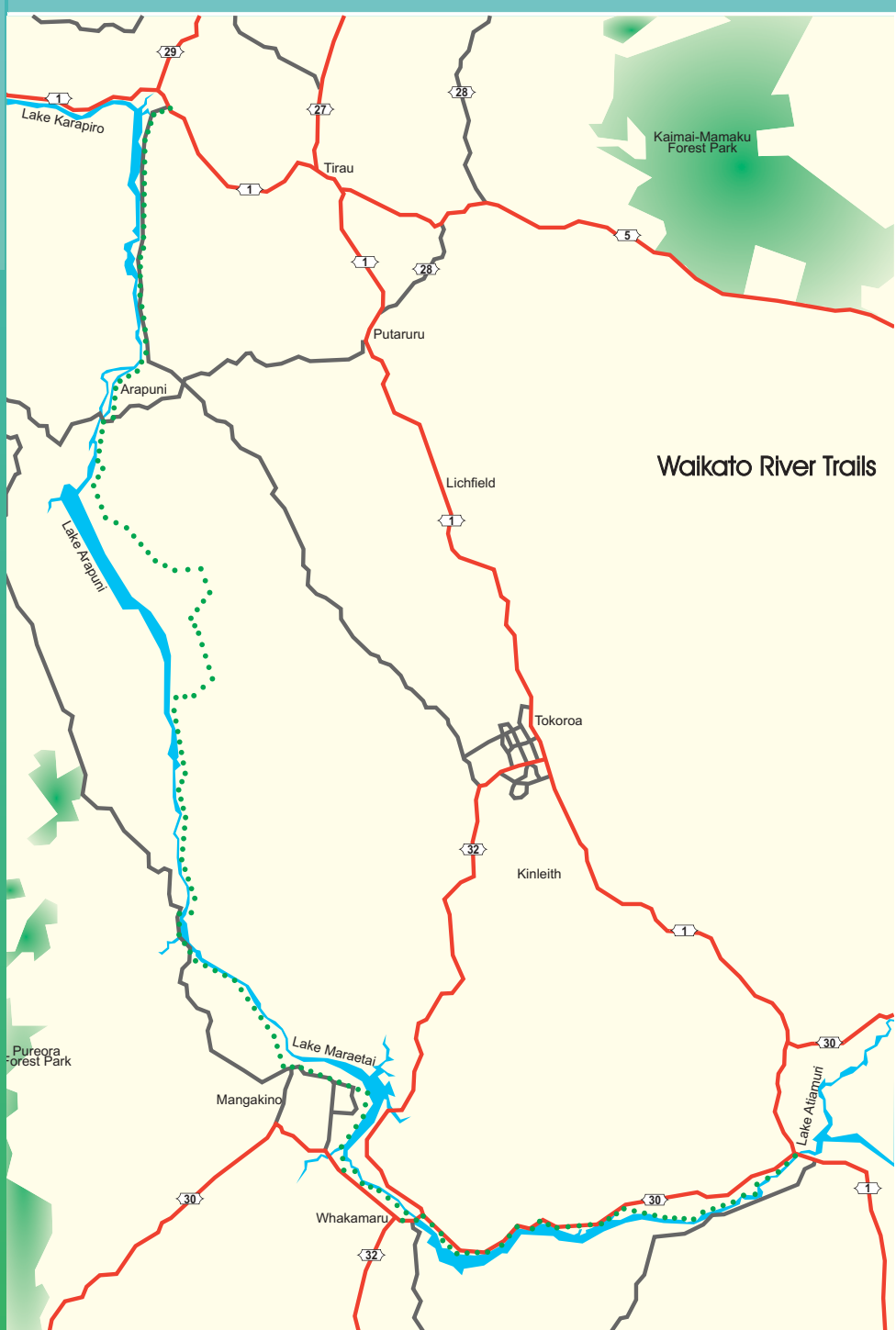
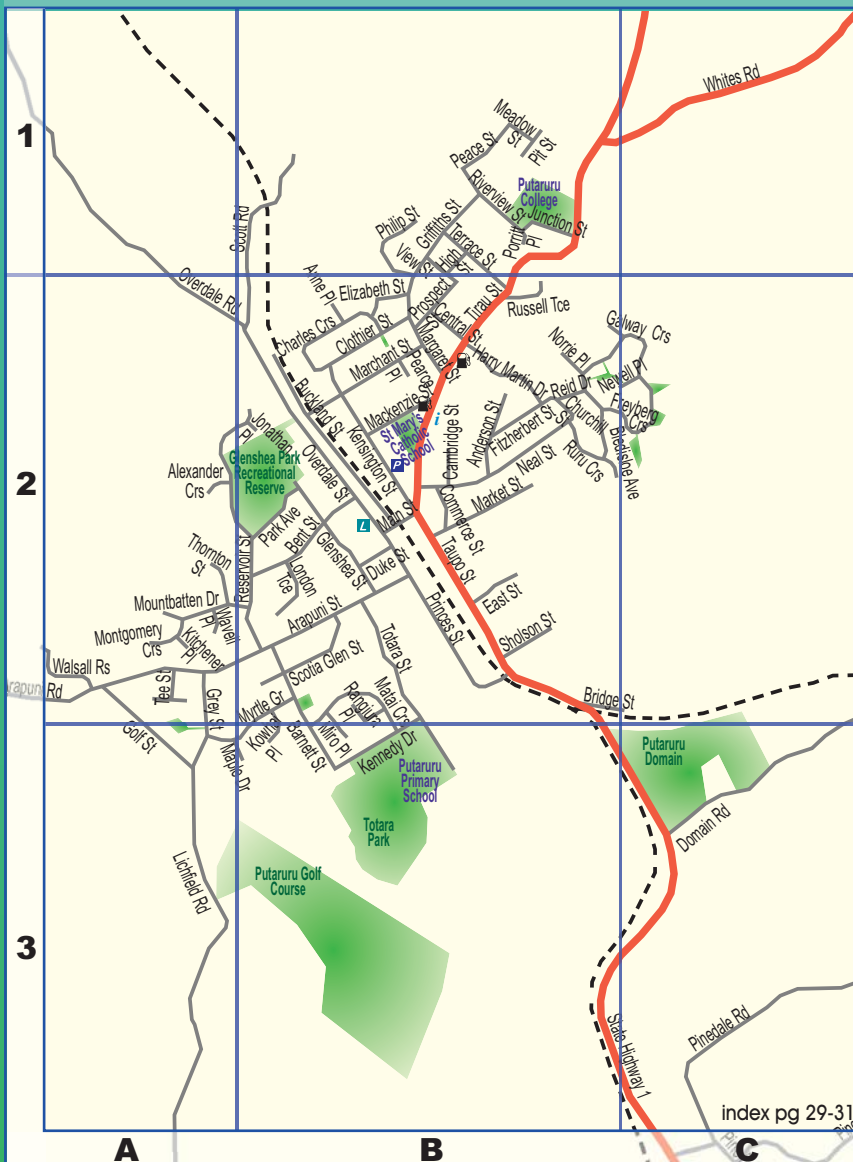
community activities, sporting and cultural events for the three-week festival. The blue colours of the **Putaruru Waterpark** mimic the colours of Te Waihou spring. Around 5000 plants - all natives - are planted on site. The shape of the feature is similar to the curve of a ponga fern shoot. The Waterpark also features two large mosaics.

Te Waotu-Arapuni Heritage Trail links the unique heritage resources of two areas of the South Waikato District. This trail is comprised of six sites - **Stone House**, **Te Waotu School**, **Jim Barnett Reserve**, **Jones Landing**, **Arapuni Hydro Station** and **Duxfield**

Reserve. The Arapuni Dam and Swing Bridge are well worth the 15 minute drive, walk across the swing bridge and look down on the awesome native foliage below and swirling waters from the power station.

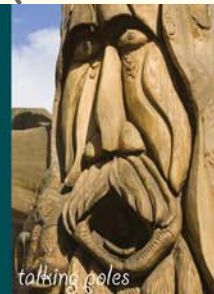

Tokoroa is the hub of New Zealand's massive forestry, timber, pulp and paper industries. WAIKATO RIVER TRAILS

After eight years of development the Waikato River Trails opened in November 2011, adding another dimension to the richness of the South Waikato. The Waikato River Trails is the second full "Great Ride" to be completed under Nga Haerenga, The New Zealand Cycle Trail. With 100km of cycling and walking trails along the Mighty Waikato, the Waikato River Trails offers some of New Zealand's most stunning views and spectacular scenery - seen and appreciated from previously inaccessible Southern Waikato land. Walkers and cyclists can choose just one section of the trails or take more time to cover the entire distance, enjoying New Zealand native bush, grassed farmland, exotic forest, open reserves, wetlands, historic landmarks, interesting rock formations and geological delights. Glyn and Bridget and the team at Waikato River Trails are experts at putting together trail packages to accommodate a variety of needs. Bike and helmet hireage is available as well as a convenient shuttle service to ensure you, your bike and

your luggage are transported safely to your drop off point or your accommodation.

The best time to ride the trail is September to May. The Waikato has a temperate climate so all but the mid-winter months are ideal for riding. The trails are largely protected from the wind. 48km of the trails are already open and in use, 47km are completed but yet to be opened, and 5km are still under construction. The remaining 5km sections are at lakes Arapuni and Maraetai. SH1 provides key access points to both ends of the trail. To the north, access is off SH1 onto Horahora Road, driving for 5km before reaching the Pokaiwhenua Bridge car park which is the starting point of the Karapiro Trail. And to the south, access is off SH1 onto Ongaroto Road (SH30); 50m from the turnoff brings you to the start of the Atiamuri Trail.



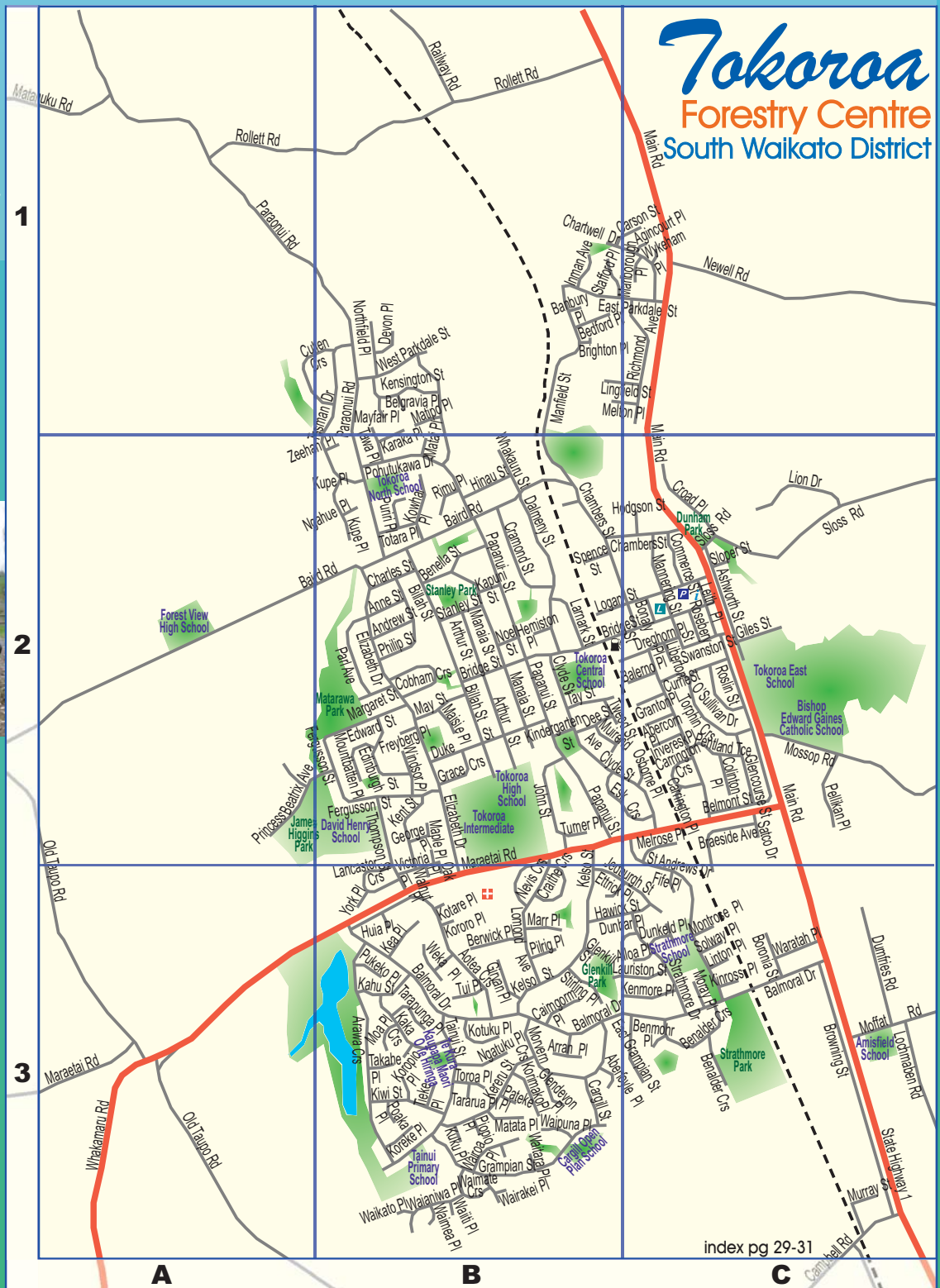

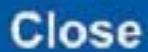
