It's Hamilton's 150th birthday this year and the city commemorates 150 years since the arrival of the first European settlers. August was the official birthday month with a public civic ceremony where the official Hamilton 150 song was performed for the first time and a time capsule buried.

Join a family-friendly party in the CBD between Ward St and Hood St. Old-style games, such as an egg and spoon race, vintage markets and ethnic food stalls.

Birthday Timewarp: 22 November

In November it will be 10 years since the Riff Raff statue was placed in Embassy Square, also known as Riff Raff Park. The cast bronze sculpture, created by Weta Workshop, has become a city icon.

Recycling is a process to change (waste) materials into new products to prevent waste of potentially useful materials, reduce the consumption of fresh raw materials, reduce energy usage, reduce air and water pollution by reducing the need for "conventional" waste disposal, and lower greenhouse gas emissions.

Recyclable materials include many kinds of glass, paper, metal, plastic, textiles, and electronics. The composting or other reuse of biodegradable waste, such as food or garden waste, is also considered recycling. Materials to be recycled are either brought to a collection center or picked up from the curbside, then sorted, cleaned, and re-processed into new materials bound for manufacturing.

E-Waste is the fastest growing category of hazardous waste. E-Waste means computers, cell phones, old televisions etc, which contain non-biodegradable metal and plastic components and lead, mercury or other toxic chemicals.

Is Your Vehicle Safe on the Road??

It doesn't take long to give your car a quick safety check.
Take it to an expert
if you think anything's wrong.

TYRES

- Check the tread depth. Minimum legal depth is 1.5mm but the more tread you have the better the grip and the safer you'll be.
- Check the tyre pressure - correct levels can usually be found on the inside door frame.
- Look for cracks or bubbles in the sides.
- Look for sharp objects stuck in the tyres.

WINDSCREEN, WIPERS AND MIRRORS

- Check your wiper blades for wear and tear.
- Clean mirrors & windscreen inside and out.
- Get your windscreen fixed if it's chipped or cracked.
- Check your windscreen washer fluid is full and the spray is working.

INDICATORS

- Turn your hazard lights on and walk around the car - check all indicators are flashing.

RUST

- Look for obvious areas of corrosion that can weaken the car's structure.

LIGHTS

- Check lenses are clean and not cracked or hazy.
- Check your headlights, reversing lights and brake lights are working. Check your back lights by reversing close to a wall so you can see the reflection in your rear view mirror.

BRAKES

You could have a problem with your brakes if:

- the brake pedal feels spongy
- there's a squealing noise when braking
- the steering pulls to one side when you brake

- there are vibrations or pulsing through the brake pedal when braking.

EXHAUST

If it's smoky or sounding unusual, it could be a sign that there's a problem.

SUSPENSION AND STEERING

You could have a problem with shock absorbers, which directly affect steering if:

- the steering wheel shakes a lot after you hit a bump or pothole
- your car seems unstable on rough or unsealed roads
- your car continues to rock after coming to a standstill.

NOISES

Listen for unusual noises, they usually indicate something is wrong.

Waikato District Health Board serves a population of 373,220 and covers 21,220 square kilometres. It stretches from northern Coromandel almost to Mt Ruapehu in the south, and from Raglan on the west coast to Waihi on the east. It takes in the city of Hamilton and towns such as Thames, Huntly, Cambridge, Te Awamutu, Matamata, Morrinsville, Ngaruawahia, Te Kuiti, Tokoroa and Taumarunui. There are 10 territorial local authorities within Waikato DHB boundaries – Hamilton City, Hauraki, Matamata-Piako, Otorohanga, (part of) Ruapehu, South Waikato, Thames, Coromandel, Waikato, Waipa, and Waitomo.

Waikato Hospital started as a small kauri farm cottage overlooking Lake Rotorua in Hamilton in the 1880s. Today it stands as a sprawling campus and part of Waikato District Health, an organisation that employs more than 6000 people and offers hospital and community based health services across the Waikato. From 2004, a \$430 million redevelopment of Thames and Waikato hospitals has resulted in several totally new facilities, major upgrades to others and the demolition of an older ward block. This major redevelopment project was completed by June 2014.

As part of the celebration of Hamilton's 150th anniversary, we are pleased to feature the historical photo (above right), courtesy of Hamilton West School. It was taken in 1940, when the Waikato Hospital Board took over the newly built Hamilton West School site on Hammond Street and used it as a military hospital. This photo is taken outside the main entrance to the school building. Unfortunately the names of the nurses are unknown. The school was chosen due to its proximity to the main hospital, the newness of the buildings and the fact the main hospital

couldn't cope with the large number of influenza cases from the Hopu Hopu army camp... The decision was made to commandeer the new school as a temporary hospital ward much to the disgust of the school headmaster, parents, PTA and board.

VELODROME BIKE PRACTICE PARK

Hey Kids, get the whole family and bring your bikes to try out the new kids only practice park at the Avanti Velodrome on State Highway 1. There is a mini road for practicing traffic safety, including lights and intersections. Parents can wait and watch in the shade while kids go through their paces.

Then there is the mountain bike practice track, for those kids wishing to try out some of the techniques and challenges of mountain biking. TE AWA RIVER RIDE

It will be 70km long when complete, easy Grade 2.

EVACUATION AND SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

First Aid

If someone you care for is injured in a disaster, your knowledge of first aid will be invaluable. Many organisations provide first aid training courses. Consider taking a first aid course, followed by regular refresher sessions. You can buy ready-made first aid kits or make up your own. A list of the minimum recommended items for first aid kits can be downloaded from www.getthru.govt.nz.

People with Disabilities or Special Requirements

If you, or a member of your household or community has a disability or any special requirement that may affect the ability to cope in a disaster, make arrangements now to get the support needed.

Build a Personal Support Network

- Organise a personal support network of a minimum of three people to alert you to civil defence warnings, or to help if you need to be evacuated. This could be family members, carers, friends, neighbours or co-workers.
- Ensure you have an emergency plan before a disaster happens and practice it with your support network.
- Discuss your needs with the support network and make sure everyone knows how to operate necessary equipment.
- Inform your support team if you are travelling or away from home.

In Case of Evacuation

- Keep at least seven days' supply of your essential medications and make provisions for those that require refrigeration.
- Wear a medical alert tag or bracelet to identify your disability or health condition.
- When travelling, let a hotel or motel manager know of your requirements in case of an emergency.
- Know where to go for assistance if you are dependent on a dialysis machine or other life-sustaining equipment or treatment.

Special food requirements

If you, or someone you are caring for, have special dietary needs, make sure there is sufficient stock of these food items for at least seven days at home, and in the emergency getaway kit. If you have to be evacuated, emergency shelters are unlikely to have the special food items you may need.

Pets and Livestock

If you have pets, domestic animals or livestock, include them in your emergency planning.

- Attach a permanent disc to your pet's collar that clearly states your phone number, name and address. Microchip your pets.
- Ensure you have a carry box, towel or blanket, emergency food, and a lead and muzzle as part of your pet's emergency getaway kit. Put your name, phone number and address on the box.
- In the event of an evacuation take your pets with you if you can safely do so. Take their vaccination records and essential medications with you as this will help your pet be re-housed if necessary. Welfare or civil defence centres generally will not accept pets except for service animals such as guide dogs. Some communities have established sheltering options for pets.
- Make in-case-of-evacuation arrangements with friends or relatives outside your neighbourhood or area.
- Keep a list of "pet-friendly" hotels and motels and their contact details in case you have to evacuate your home or neighbourhood.
- If you have domestic animals (such as horses, pigs or poultry) or livestock, know which paddocks are safe to move livestock away from floodwaters, landslides and power lines. In the event of an evacuation, ensure you have a plan in place so that they will be secure and have food, water and shelter. The responsibility for animal welfare remains with the owner.
- Check with your council about local arrangements for assisting with domestic animal issues.

Storing Water

3 Litres per person per day for drinking

Household water supplies, including drinking water, could be affected in a disaster so having a supply of stored water is absolutely essential. You need at least three litres of drinking water for each person each day. You will also need water for washing and cooking. You can purchase bottled water or prepare your own containers of water. Purchase food-grade water storage containers from camping or hardware stores or recycle plastic soft drink bottles. Do not use milk containers as protein cannot be adequately removed with washing, and may harbour bacteria.

Instructions for safely storing water

- Wash bottles thoroughly in hot water.
- Fill each bottle with tap water until it overflows.
- Add five drops of household bleach per litre of water (or half a teaspoon for 10 litres) and put in storage. Do not drink for at least 30 minutes after disinfecting.
- Label each bottle with dates showing when the bottles were filled and when they need to be refilled.
- Check the bottles every 12 months. If the water is not clear, throw it out and refill clean bottles with clean water and bleach.
- Store bottles away from direct sunlight in a cool dark place. Keep them in two separate places and where there is not likely to be flooding.
- You can also fill plastic ice cream containers with water, cover, label and keep in the freezer. These can help keep food cool if the power is off and can also be used for drinking.
- Your hot water cylinder and toilet cistern are valuable sources of water. Check that your hot water cylinder and header tank are well secured.
- Do not put chemical cleaners in the cistern if you want to use the water. If you use collected rain water make sure that you disinfect it with household bleach. If you are uncertain about the quality of water, e.g. from a well that has been flooded, or if it might have been contaminated by smoke or volcanic ash, do not drink it.

Emergency Sanitation

In some emergency situations the water supply may be cut off, or water and sewage lines may be damaged, and you may need to use improvised emergency toilets.

- Use watertight containers such as a rubbish bin or bucket, with a snug-fitting cover.
- If the container is small, keep a large container with a snug-fitting cover available for waste disposal.
- Line bins with plastic bags if possible, and keep the toilet covered.
- Pour or sprinkle a small amount of regular household disinfectant such as chlorine bleach into the container each time the toilet is used to reduce odour and germs.

Get Your Car Ready

Plan ahead for what you will do if you are in your car when a disaster strikes. In some emergencies you may be stranded in your vehicle for some time. A flood, snow storm or major traffic accident could make it impossible to proceed.

- Consider having essential emergency survival items in your car. If you are driving in extreme winter conditions, add windshield scrapers, brush, shovel, tire chains and warm clothing to your emergency kit.
- Store a pair of walking shoes, waterproof jacket, essential medicines, snack food, water and a torch in your car.
- When planning travel, keep up-to-date with weather & road information.

Emergency Plans for Businesses

Under the Health and Safety in Employment Act, businesses have an obligation to be prepared for an emergency. Put together a Workplace Emergency Plan for your business.

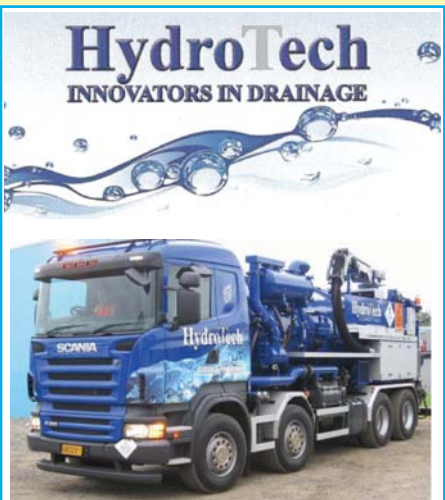

North Waikato Region

State Highway 1 runs down through this area and is in the process of being up-graded to the Waikato Expressway, known as the Longswamp section which will join up at Taupiri to the Gordonton/Ngaru-awahia/Hamilton section. The Expressway will bypass Huntly and will be completed in 2016 and will make the journey to and from Auckland considerably faster. The area was important historically during the Waikato Wars, as the colonialists pushed down into the Waikato. Along the highway are historic sites for both sides, redoubts and Pa sites, the most famous is the Rangiriri Pa site where the final stand of Maori and Pakeha soldiers was fought out. At Rangiriri the casualties of this engagement are buried in the small cemetery. Many of the historical sites are signposted and can be accessed from the main highway. The Te Araroa Walkway (the Long Pathway - part of a New Zealand long walkway)

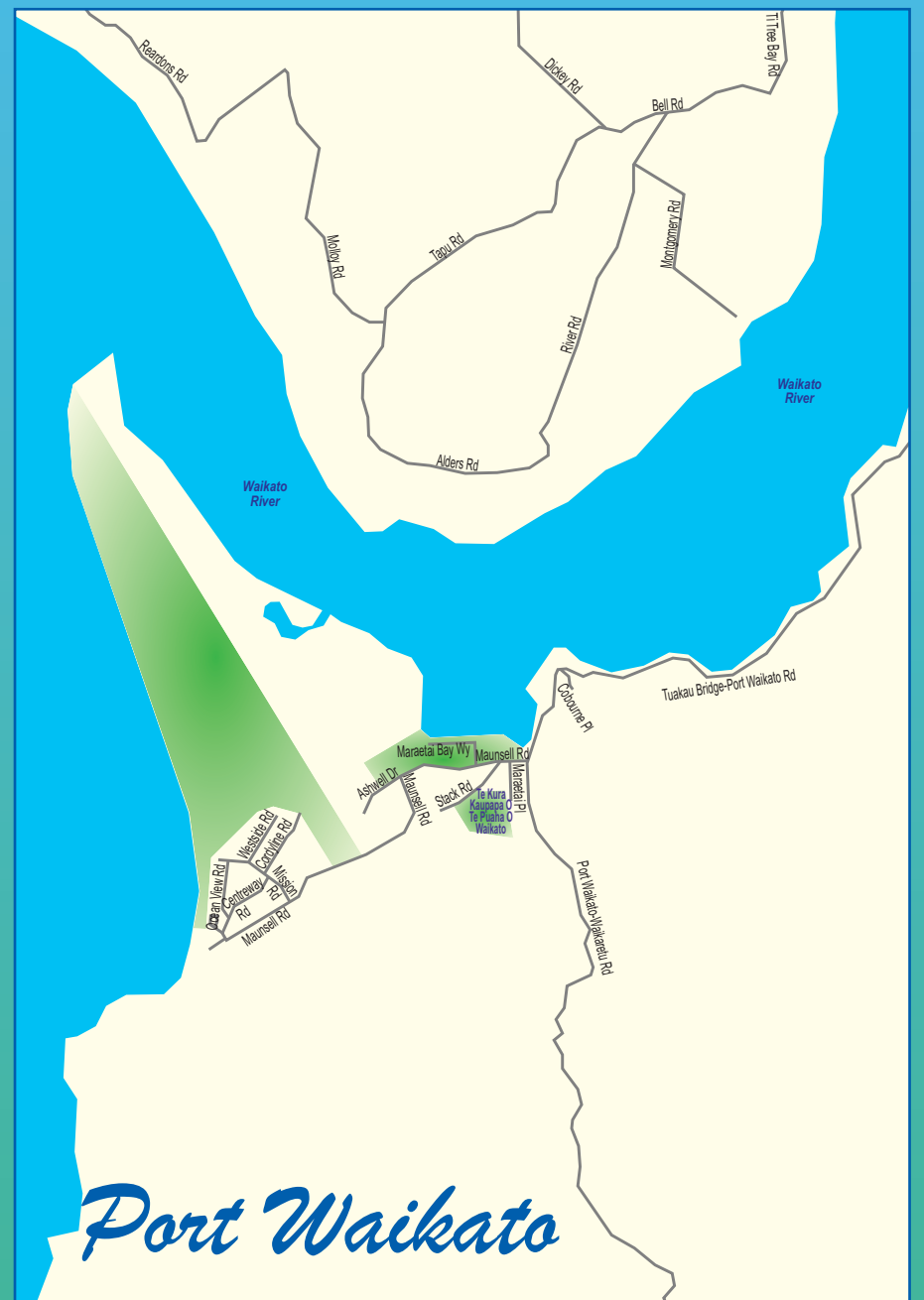
runs through the Mercer to Rangiriri section. The Whangamarino Walkway can be accessed from Oram Road at Meremere, the northern ends starts at Mercer and ends at Huntly.

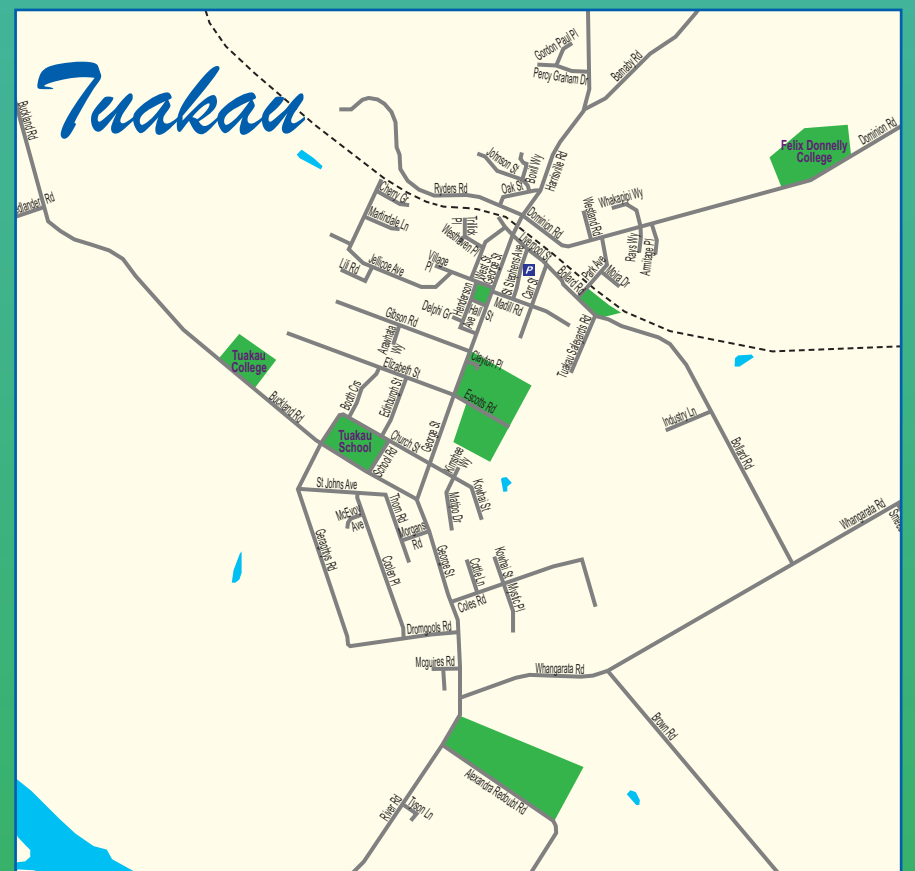
Work is being done along the Waikato River through the Whangamarino wetlands by the Waikato Rivercare Restoration Project, including planting of native species. Port Waikato is a delightful beach popular for surfing and is the only rivermouth delta with a sand bar in the Southern Hemisphere. From Port Waikato drive southward through Limestone Downs, a rugged scenic trip that passes by the Nikau cave.

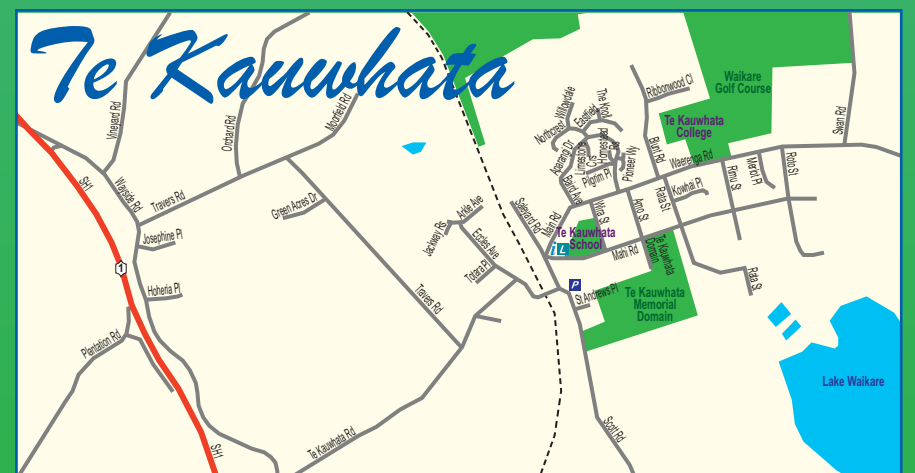

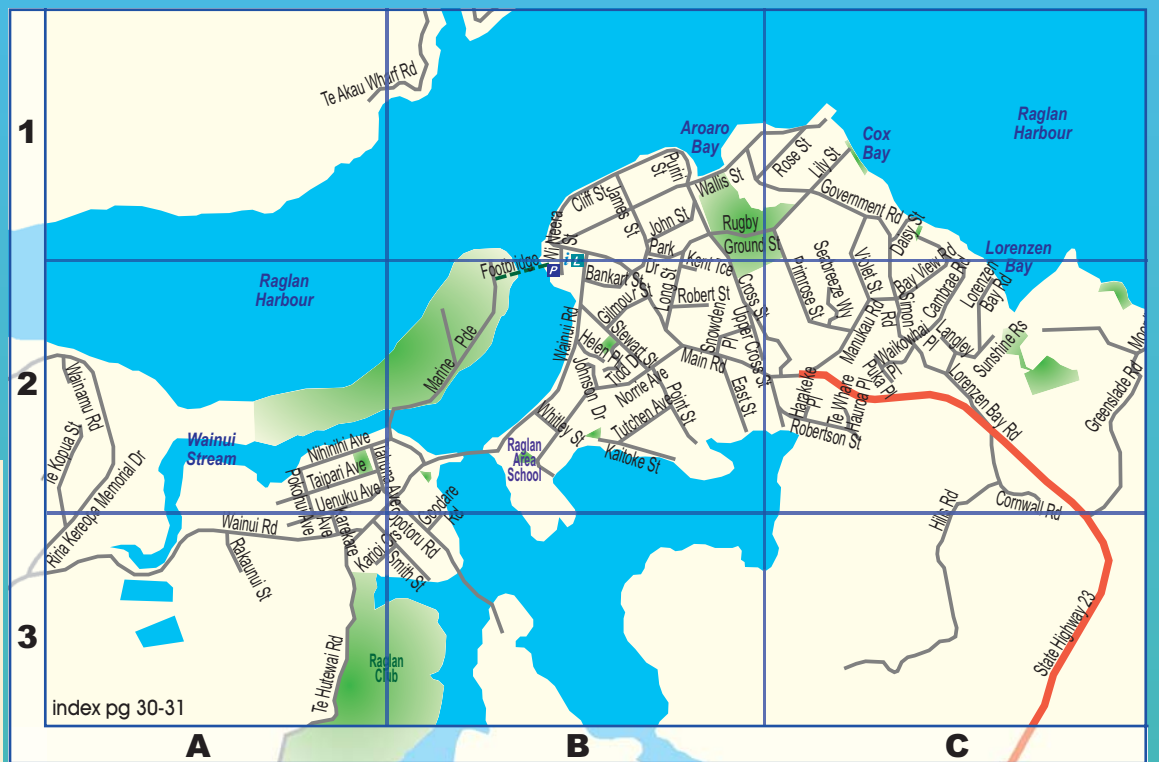

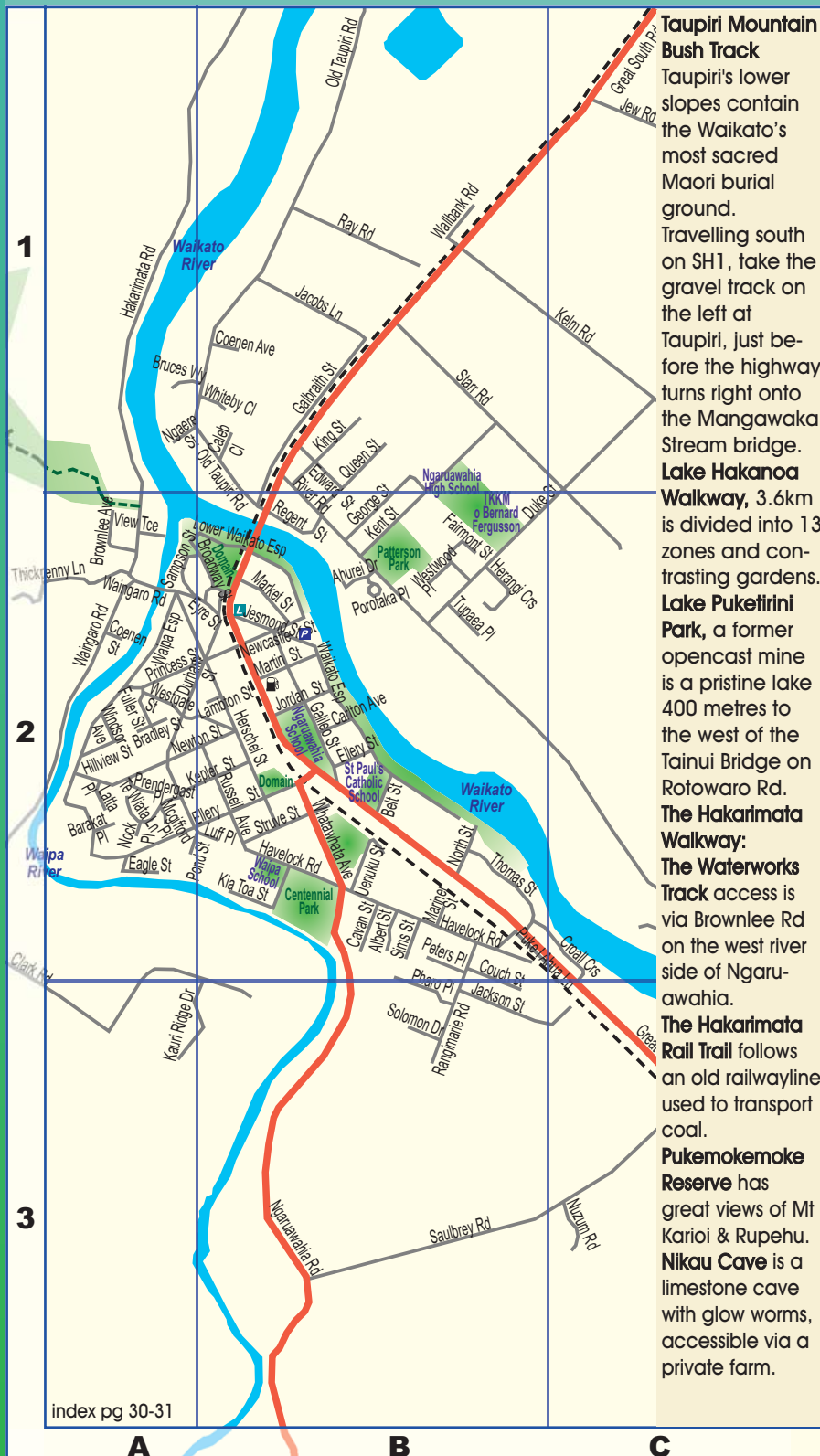

Taupiri Mountain Bush Track

Taupiri's lower slopes contain the Waikato's most sacred Maori burial ground. Travelling south on SH1, take the gravel track on the left at Taupiri, just before the highway turns right onto the Mangawaka Stream bridge.

Lake Hakanoa Walkway, 3.6km is divided into 13 zones and contrasting gardens.

Lake Puketirini Park, a former opencast mine is a pristine lake 400 metres to the west of the Tainui Bridge on Rotowaro Rd.

The Hakarimata Walkway: The Waterworks Track access is via Brownlee Rd on the west river side of Ngaruawahia.

The Hakarimata Rail Trail follows an old railwayline used to transport coal.

Pukemokemoke Reserve has great views of Mt Karioi & Rupehu.

Nikau Cave is a limestone cave with glow worms, accessible via a private farm.

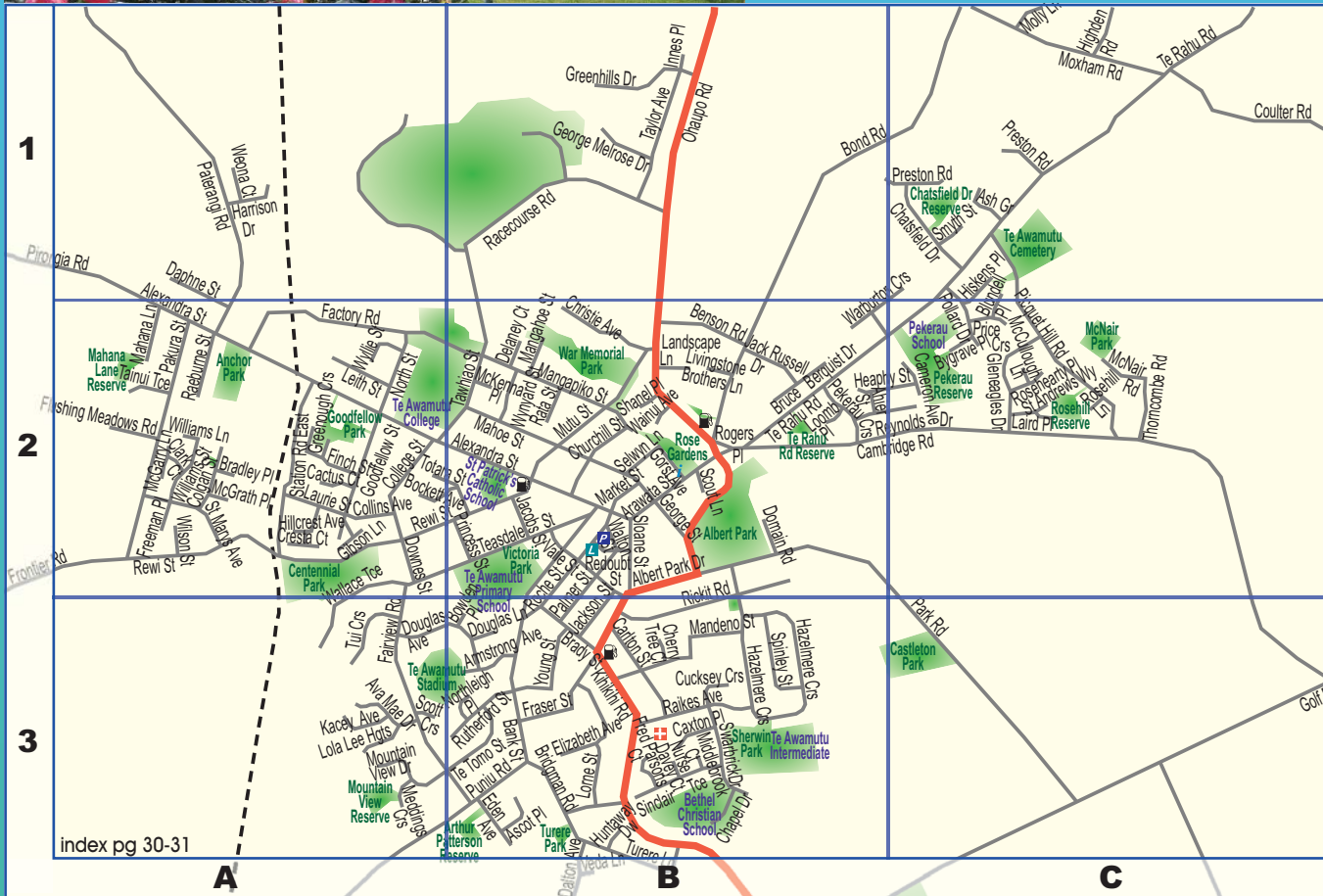

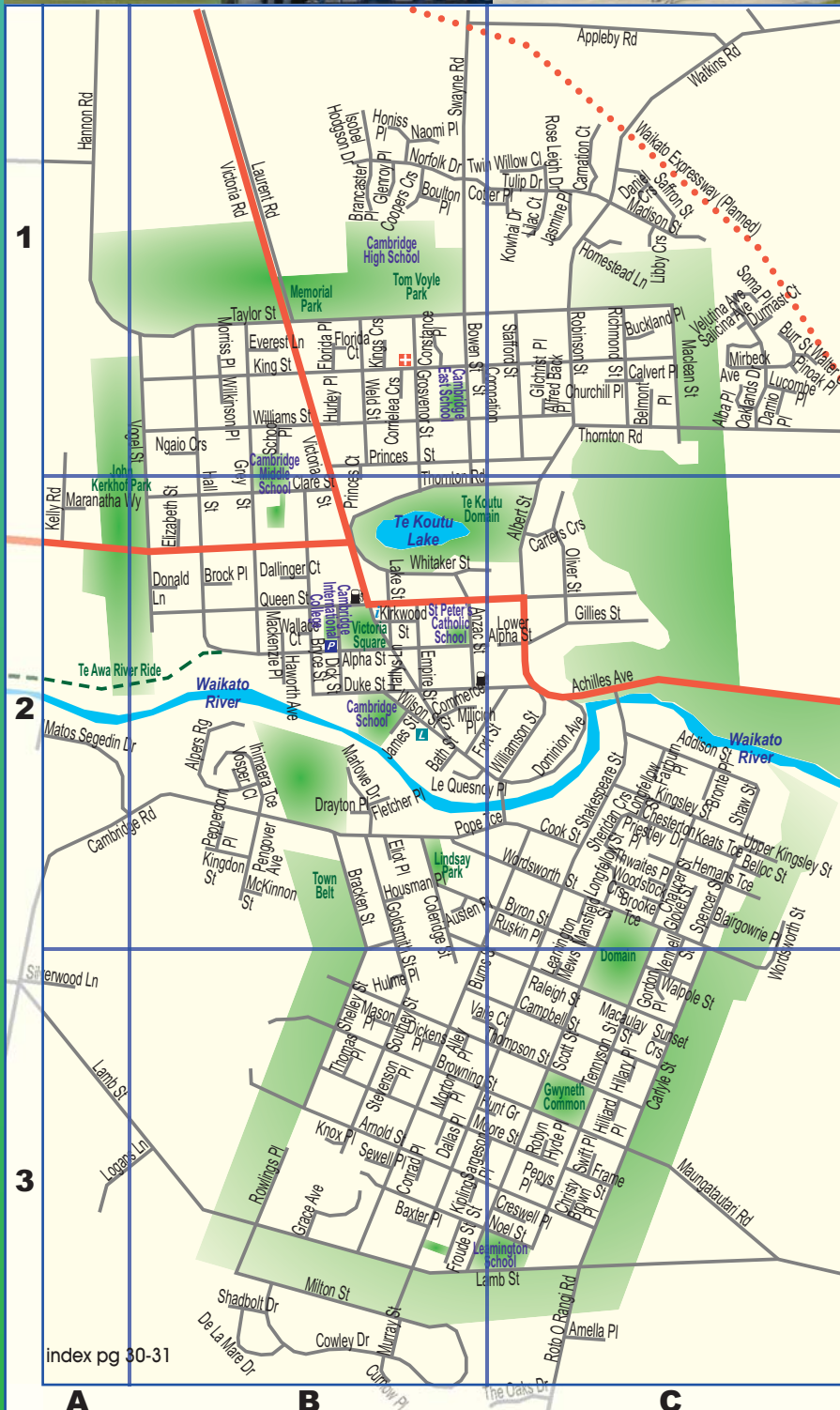

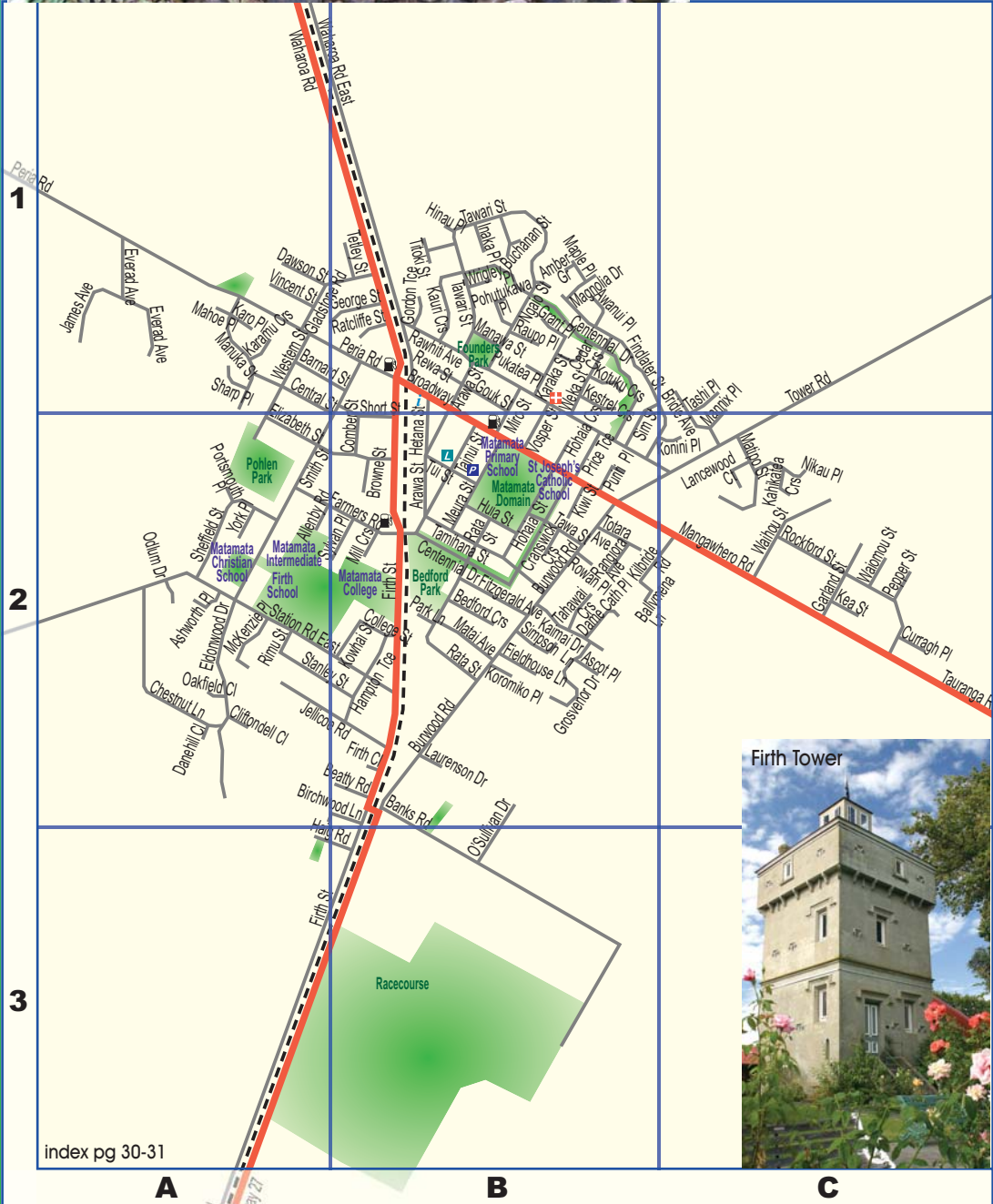

Historic Spa Town

Piako District



Te Aroha is a town with many historic associations, and this shows in its charming architectural buildings. One of the highlights is the 29 acre landscaped Edwardian style Domain which houses the Te Aroha Mineral Spas - private, indoor hot tubs filled with naturally hot soda water and the world's only hot soda fountain - the Mokena Geyser. Wander through the historic Cadman House Museum - New Zealand's original sanatorium. The Domain is also home to the Te Aroha Leisure pools complex - public, outdoor, heated pools, including outdoor spa, designed for a diverse range of visitors. Start the day with a picnic in the Domain, and then proceed with one of the many bushwalks, including a track from the park up the mountain or some mountain biking - there is a huge network of walking and mountain bike tracks in the Kaimai-Mamaku Forest Park. A 100-year-old track starting near the bottom of Mt Te Aroha leads to Tutumangao Waterfall. Follow the Heritage Trail of fine historic buildings

and monuments dating back to the early 1880s. The Waiorongomai Valley is a significant gold mining site in the Kaimai-Mamaku Forest Park. The valley offers numerous walks following old mining trails. A prospector, Hone Werahiko found gold in the Waiorongomai Valley in 1881. The Piako County Tramway was built in 1882-83 and is New Zealand's oldest known railway with the original rail still in place, a showcase historic site for the Department of Conservation. There are a number of historic areas to explore in the valley, such as Hardy's Hut, Fern Spur Incline and winding gear, the Bendigo Battery, the Low Level Drive, and the May Queen Incline and winding gear. The Waiorongomai Valley lies at the end of Waiorongomai Loop Road. The Valley is just four kilometres south of Te Aroha, near State Highway 26.

Thames to Waihi to Te Aroha

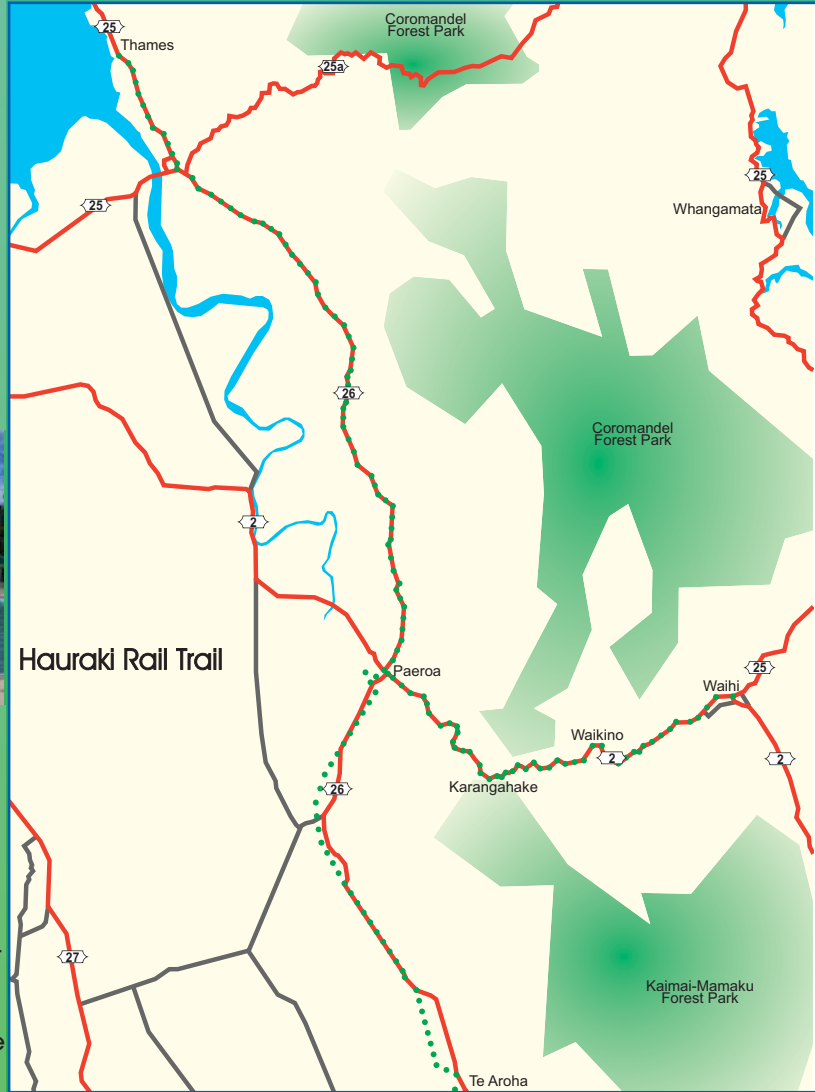
The Hauraki Rail Trail will be a three day ride for most or a two day ride for fit cyclists, making it an ideal weekend experience. It can be accessed from Thames, Paeroa, Waihi, or Te Aroha. There are shorter day riding options. The trail shows some of the best scenery in New Zealand through areas rich in pioneering history. A major highlight includes riding through the scenic Karangahake Gorge, on the Waihi stretch. The Hauraki Rail Trail is shown as a green dotted line on the map below.



Ngatea is the main service centre on the Hauraki Plains, located on SHW 2, and within an hours drive of Auckland. Nestled on the banks of the Piako River, Ngatea has an array of shops and eating establishments on offer, the picturesque water gardens to visit, and the newly developed Pioneer Park.



Miranda and Kaiaua are on the Pacific Coast Highway. Visit the internationally renowned Shorebird Centre, relax in the warm mineral pools at the Miranda Hot Springs, enjoy a day at the beach or check out the many tramping and biking tracks in the ARA Parks.

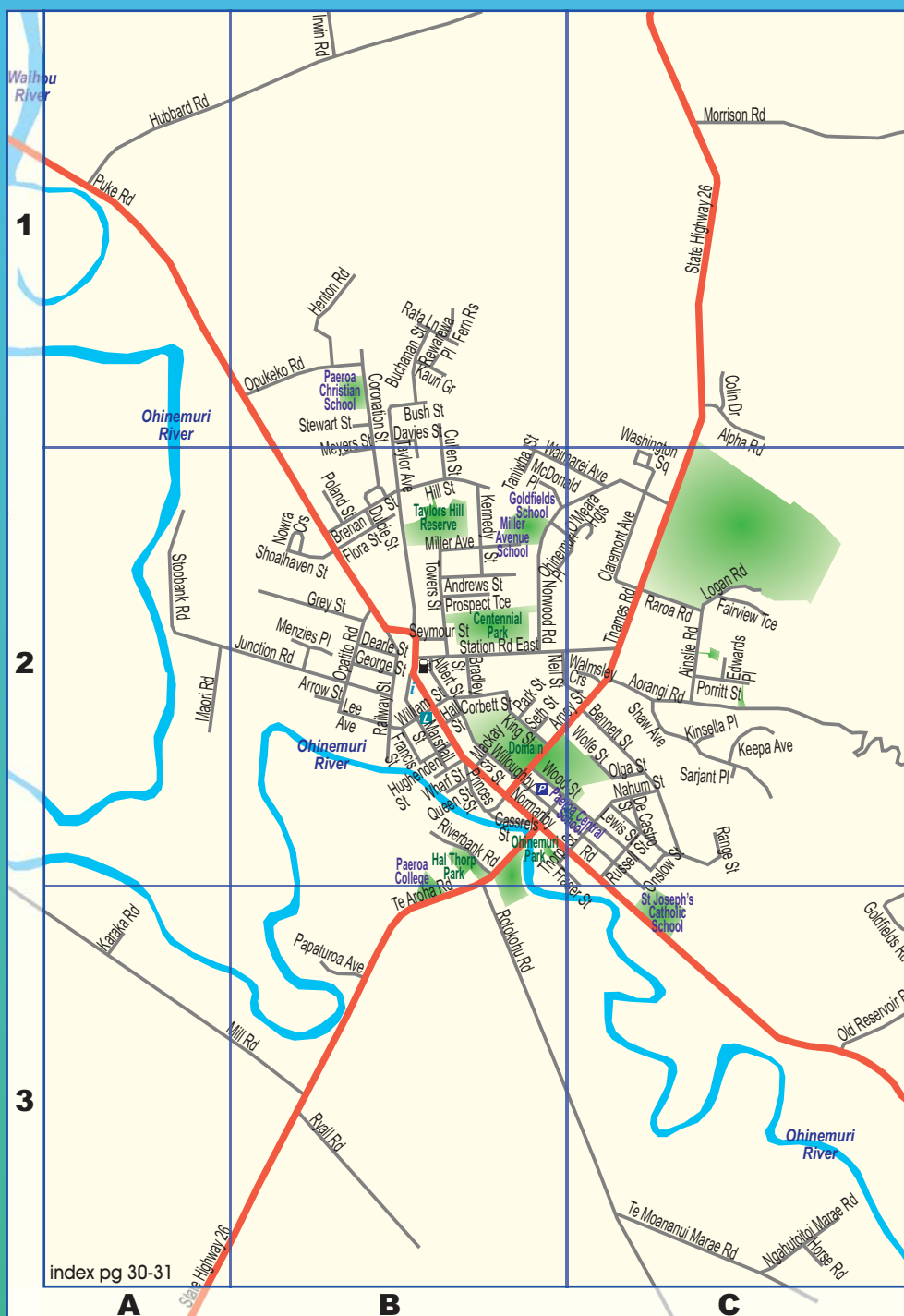

Paeroa Historic Town Hauraki District

Paeroa is "World Famous in New Zealand" and overseas – for its Big Bottle. At 7 metres high, the Lemon and Paeroa Bottle is a permanent reminder of the therapeutic Paeroa Springs Water discovered before 1900, which, with the addition of lemon, became known as New Zealand's own soft drink.

Originally a thriving river port, the town was first laid out in the 1870s and the Historic Maritime Park and Museum houses artifacts from this era. Paeroa is also known for the many antique, second hand and retro shops where you can spend hours fossicking. The site of the original gold rush in 1875, Karangahake and its "residential suburb" of Mackaytown, have returned to peaceful activities; fishing, gardens, cafes and a winery. In Karangahake, one can access the 1km long railway tunnel and the Windows Walk and follow the Ohinemuri River through to Waikino. Good swimming and picnicking sites are easily accessed. Walking tracks lead into the Kaimai-Mamaku and Coromandel Forest Parks.

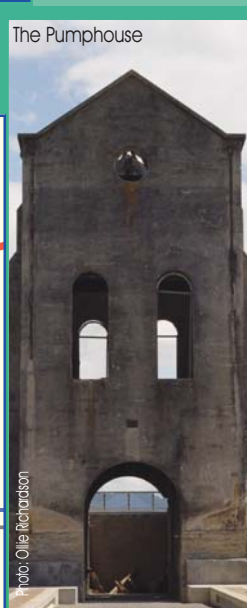

Waihi's story is a rich tapestry woven through with golden thread. You can walk right to the edge of Waihi's huge open pit gold mine. Waihi Goldmine Tours conducts daily tours of the site (bookings are essential). Local shops combine old style service with an eclectic range of goods, cafes and restaurants. Local walkways include the Pit Rim Walkway, also to the top of Black Hill and from Gilmour Lake a track follows Mill Stream around the base of Union Hill, another historic mining area. Karangahake Gorge is a historic gold mining area with spectacular scenery, swing bridges across the Ohinemuri and Waitawheta Rivers, old mining tunnels (bring a torch and sturdy footwear), bush walks. Take a scenic train trip with Goldfields Railway to Waikino to view old mining remains. Part of the Hauraki Rail Trail winds through the Karangahake Scenic Reserve and Conservation area.

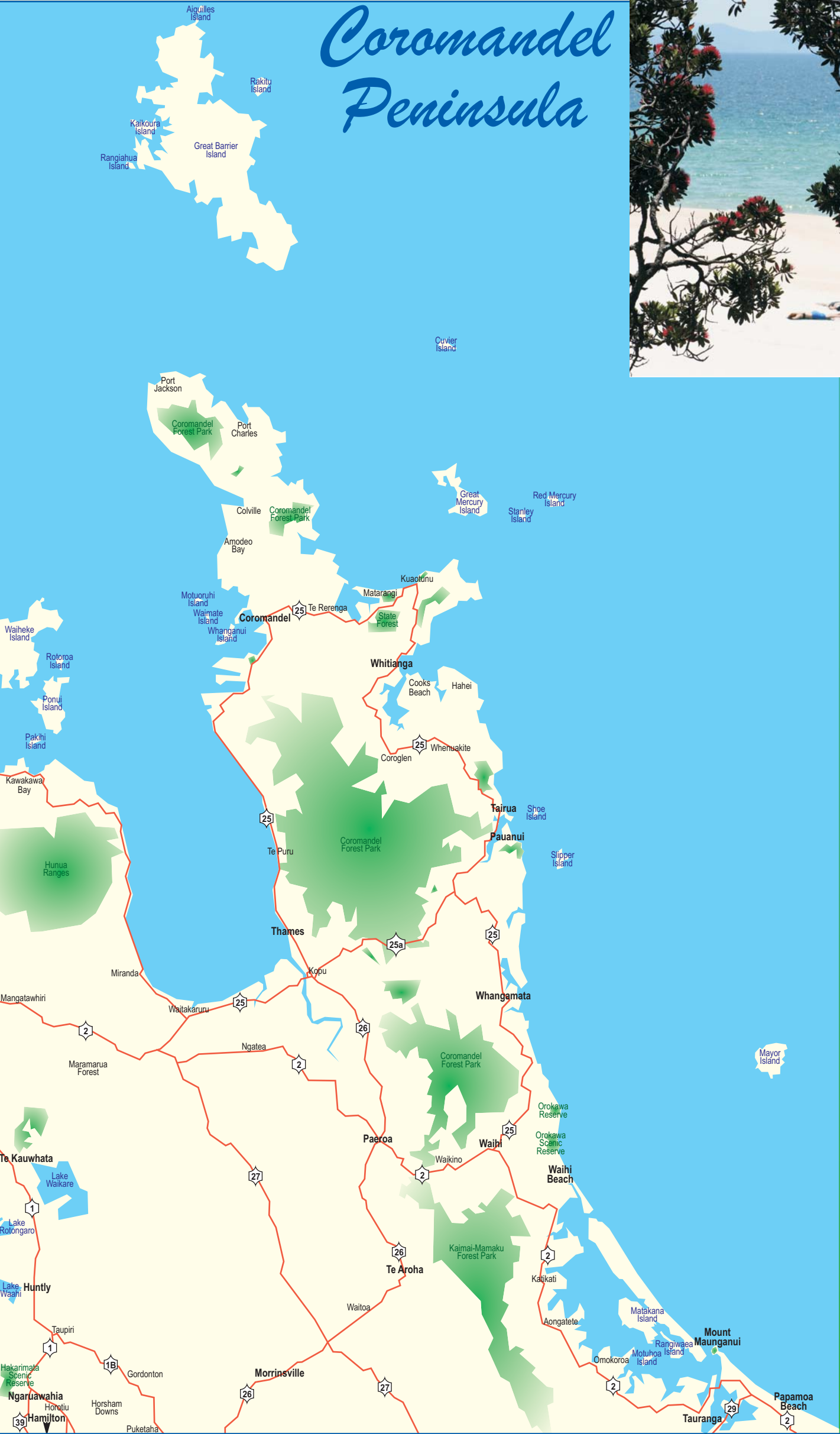

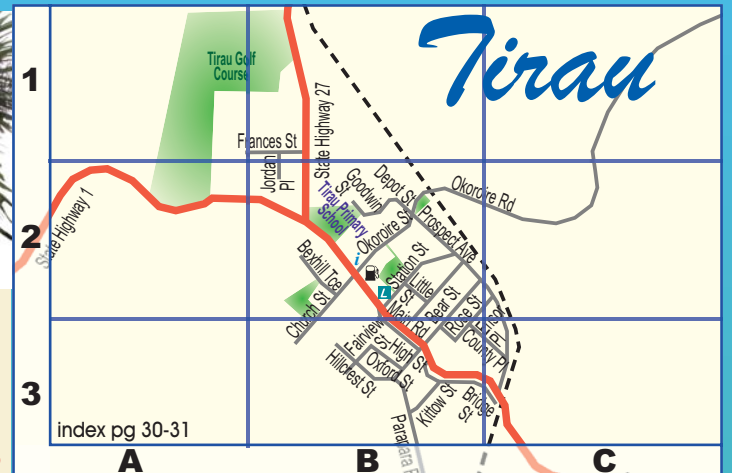

Putaruru Farming & Timber South Waikato District

Putaruru has a variety of walks - long or short. Visitors to Putaruru are invited to wander **Te Waihou Walkway** to view the **Blue Springs**. The crystal clear spring water is bottled in town, and sold commercially, nationally and beyond, as "Pump" water. Putaruru is based on a history of farming and timber and has the Lichfield Dairy Factory - which is one of the newest and largest cheese factories in the world. Visit the Putaruru Timber Museum to learn about the history of timber milling.

In even years, the District holds its Spring Into Summer Festival with a wide range of community activities, sporting and cultural events for the three-week festival. The blue colours of the **Putaruru Waterpark** mimic the colours of Te Waihou spring. Around 5000 plants - all natives - are planted on site. The shape of the feature is similar to the curve of a ponga fern shoot. The Waterpark also features two large mosaics. The **Lorraine Moller Arboretum** accessed from Harry Martin Drive, on the outskirts of Putaruru

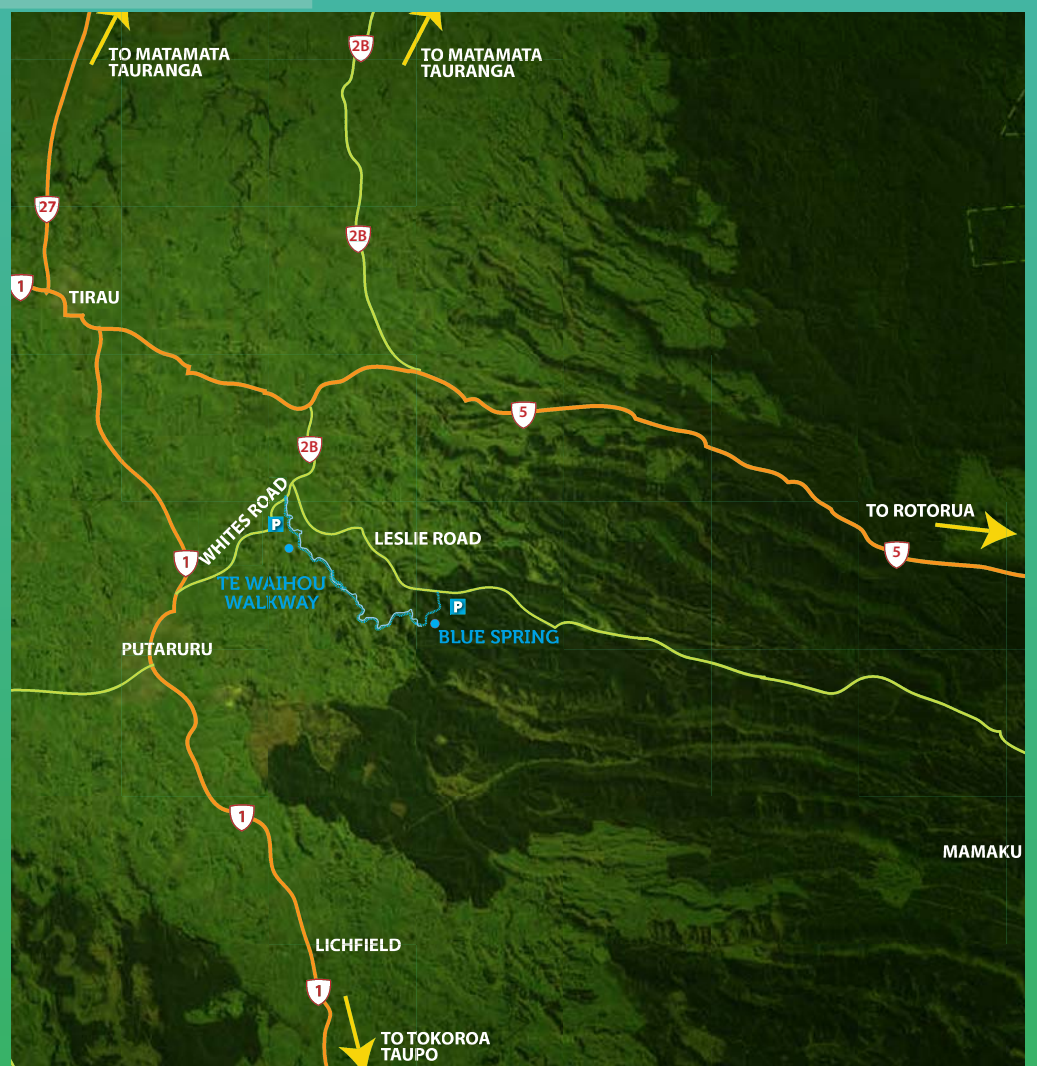
Enter the gate and follow the wheelchair accessible path to the lookout or descend to the valley floor through the labelled collection of maple, oak and dogwood. **Te Waotu-Arapuni Heritage Trail** is comprised of six sites - **Stone House**, **Te Waotu School**, **Jim Barnett Reserve**, **Jones Landing**, **Arapuni Hydro Station** and **Duxfield Reserve**. The **Arapuni Dam and Swing Bridge** are well worth the 15 minute drive, walk across the swing bridge and look down on the awesome swirling waters from the power station.

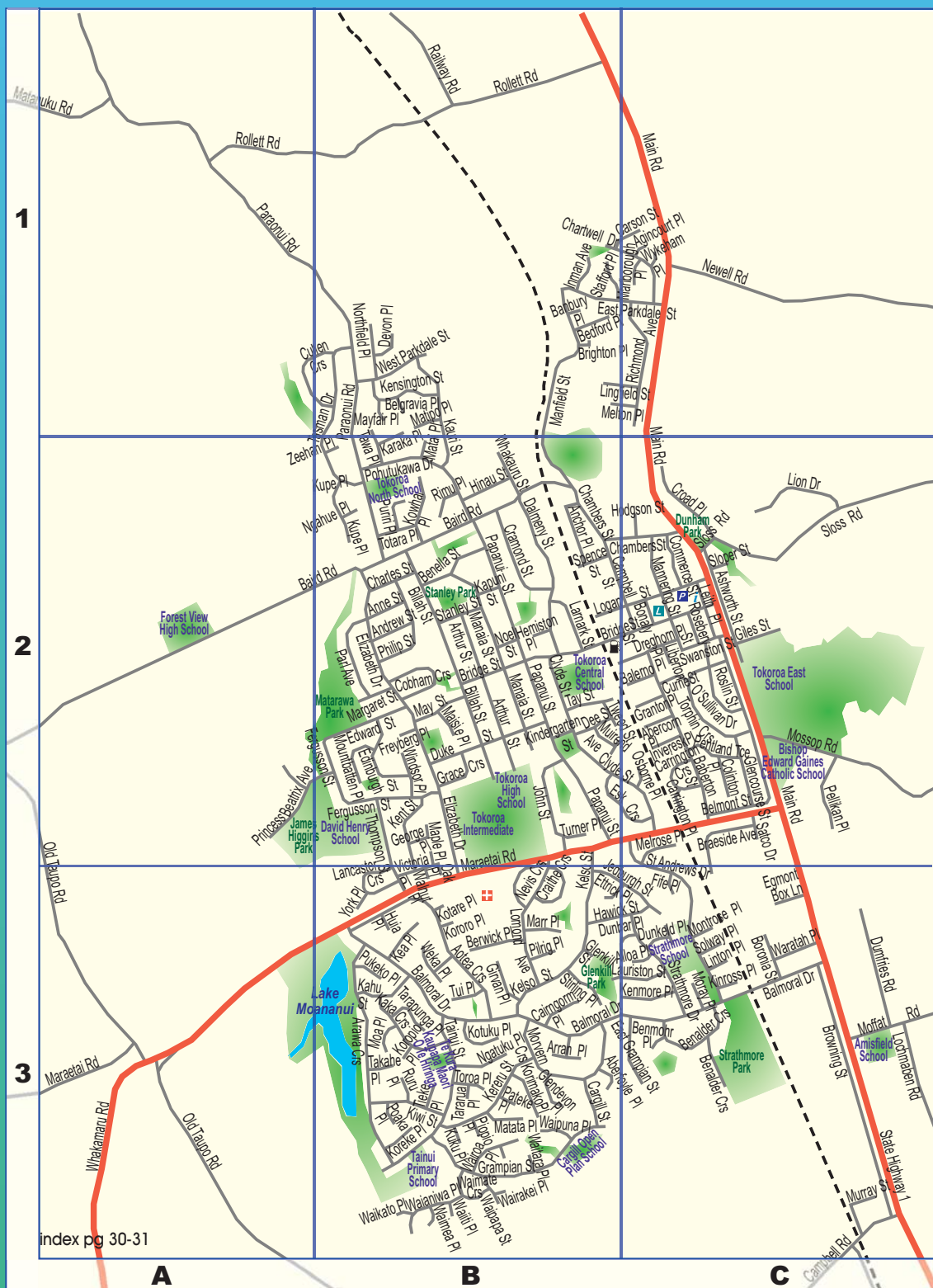

WAIKATO RIVER TRAILS

The Waikato River Trails are the second full "Great Ride" to be completed under Nga Haerenga, the New Zealand Cycle Trail. With 100km of cycling and walking trails along the Mighty Waikato, the Waikato River Trails offers some of New Zealand's most stunning views and spectacular scenery.

Walkers and cyclists can choose just one section of the trails or take more time to cover the entire distance, enjoying New Zealand native bush, grassed farmland, exotic forest, open reserves, wetlands, historic landmarks, interesting rock formations and geological delights. Glyn and Bridget and the team at Waikato River Trails are experts at putting together trail packages to accommodate a variety of

needs. Bike and helmet hireage is available as well as a convenient shuttle service to ensure you, your bike and your luggage are transported safely to your drop off point or your accommodation. The best time to ride the trail is September to May. The Waikato has a fine temperate climate so all but the mid-winter months are ideal for riding.

SH1 provides key access points to both ends of the trail. To the north, access is off SH1 onto Horahora Road, driving for 5km before reaching the Pokaiwhenua Bridge car park, which is the starting point of the Karapiro Trail. And to the south, access is off SH1 onto Ongaroto Road (SH30); 50m from the turnoff brings you to the start of the Atiamuri Trail.

Tokoroa
Forestry Centre
South Waikato District

Tokoroa is the hub of New Zealand's massive forestry, timber, pulp and paper industries. Located mid-way between Taupo and Hamilton on State Highway 1, Tokoroa is an ideal place to pause for an hour or two, or even better, for a day or two. The town takes its name after the Maori chief, "Tokoroa" who was killed as he led his people gallantly against the British in the mid 1800s. Tokoroa is the gateway to many of the central North Island's tourist attractions. There is easy access to bush walks, scenic reserves, lakes and rivers, all steeped in Maori legend. Visit Pokaiwhenua, and Hatupatu rock, learn of the stories and legends of these sacred places. The well-stocked lakes and rivers offer excellent trout fishing, boating, water skiing, yachting or simply enjoy a walk round Lake Moana-nui, by Matarawa Stream and the scenery from the look-out on Colson's Hill. There are many events in which South Waikato District Council has a direct

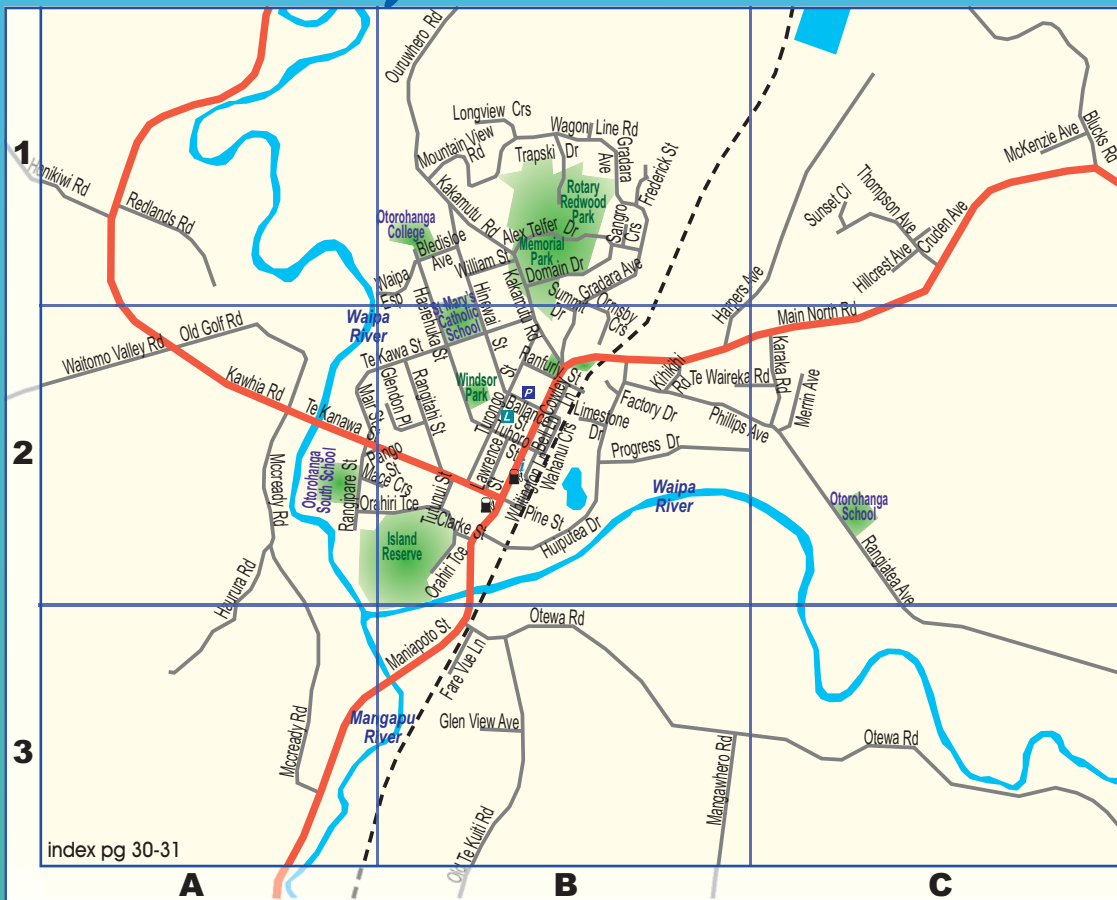

Access onto The Timber Trail is relatively easy however the trail is located within a remote back country area. There is limited cell phone coverage. Before your trip ensure you have:

- Checked the latest forecast
- Left your intentions with someone
- Warm clothing and some food.

The Timber Trail passes through the Pureora Forest Park, where riders will pass through four ecological areas showcasing remnants of the great forests that once dominated the area. The trail traverses Mount Pureora then runs along the western side of the Hauhungaroa Range before dropping down to Ongarue.

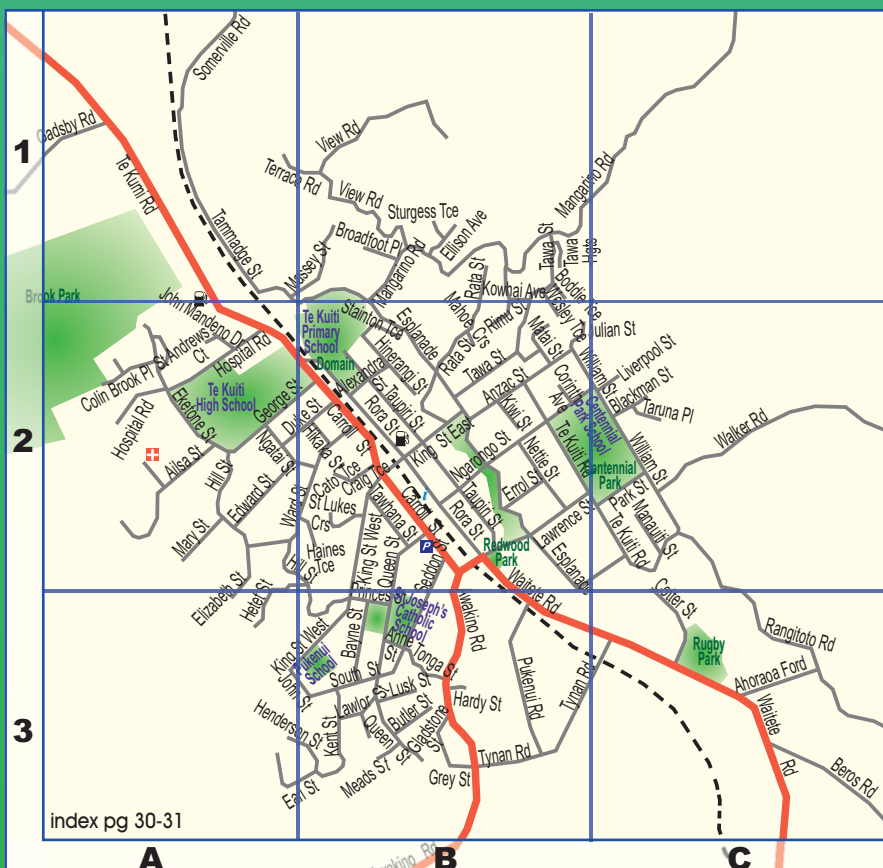
The nationally significant Ongarue Spiral is being lovingly restored to its former glory as part of the cycle trail's development. Some of New

Zealand's highest and longest suspension bridges will also be a feature of the trail. There are no food stores or petrol outlets at Pureora or Ongarue; the nearest facilities to Pureora are at Benneydale, 15 minutes west along SH30, or at Mangakino, 20 minutes east.

WAITOMO WALKS

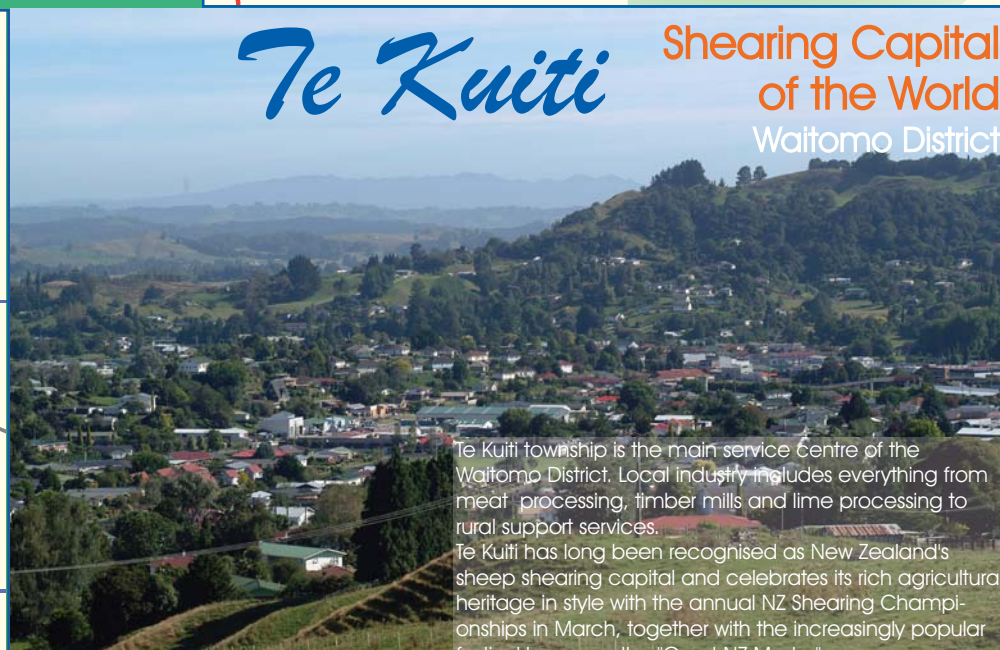
The self-guided privately run **Dundie Hill Walk** is a 27km, two-day/one-night loop walk through Waitomo's bush and farmland, including overnight bunk-house accommodation in the bush.

The Mangaokewa Scenic Reserve is a nice place to relax, go fishing or swimming. There are scenic walks as you travel south to **Ruakuri Reserve**, **Marokopa Waterfall** and **Mangapohue Natural Bridge**, **Piripiri Cave** and drive on to the coast to Marokopa beach for fishing and Kiritehere for fossil fossicking.



Te Kuiti

Shearing Capital of the World Waitomo District



Te Kuiti township is the main service centre of the Waitomo District. Local industry includes everything from meat processing, timber mills and lime processing to rural support services.

Te Kuiti has long been recognised as New Zealand's sheep shearing capital and celebrates its rich agricultural heritage in style with the annual NZ Shearing Championships in March, together with the increasingly popular festival known as the "Great NZ Muster".

Check out the new Pa Harakeke Eco Cultural Centre at 138 Maraeroa Rd, for a unique look into Maori traditions and culture.

There is an 18-hole golf course in Piopio, where sheep maintain the fairways!

To the south-west is the picturesque Mokau surf beach.
