Not to be missed for those visiting Hamilton.

There is great shopping available in Hamilton with most shops open in the weekend and Hamilton is less than 2hrs

from Auckland, Rotorua and Tauranga. Shopping in the city centre includes the Downtown Plaza, CentrePlace with the Sky City cinemas and in the North, the splendid Westfield Chartwell mall.

The city has an abundance of beautiful parks including the fabulous Hamilton Gardens, the Waikato River with annual Gallagher Boat Race, Hamilton Lake, the Hamilton Zoo and Te Rapa Race-course. The scenic walkways along the river and around the lake are very attractive and well maintained.

Of interest is the Waikato Museum of

Art & History on the banks of the river at the south end of Victoria Street. Hamilton is well provided with sports facilities including the Mystery Creek Events and Convention Centre which hosts the Motor Show, the Boat Show, the New Zealand Agricultural Fieldays, the fine golf courses and of course, the magnificent Waikato Rugby Stadium which host the Waikato Chiefs.

Hamilton now also hosts the fabulous ITM 400 V8 Supercar race. Visitors to Hamilton will find plenty of accommodation available and a bus transport system in place to service all requirements, as well as Hamilton International Airport for direct flights to the city. Visitors at Christmas time can admire the spectacular Christmas light display at the Mormon Temple at Templeview.

Famous as a diverse agricultural centre, Hamilton is also close to outlying scenic attractions such as numerous bush areas with walking tracks, for example Maungatautari near Cambridge, Raglan with its beaches, Waingaro Hot Springs, Te Aroha and Matamata hot pools, bush walks, homestays and thoroughbred racing stables to visit. 



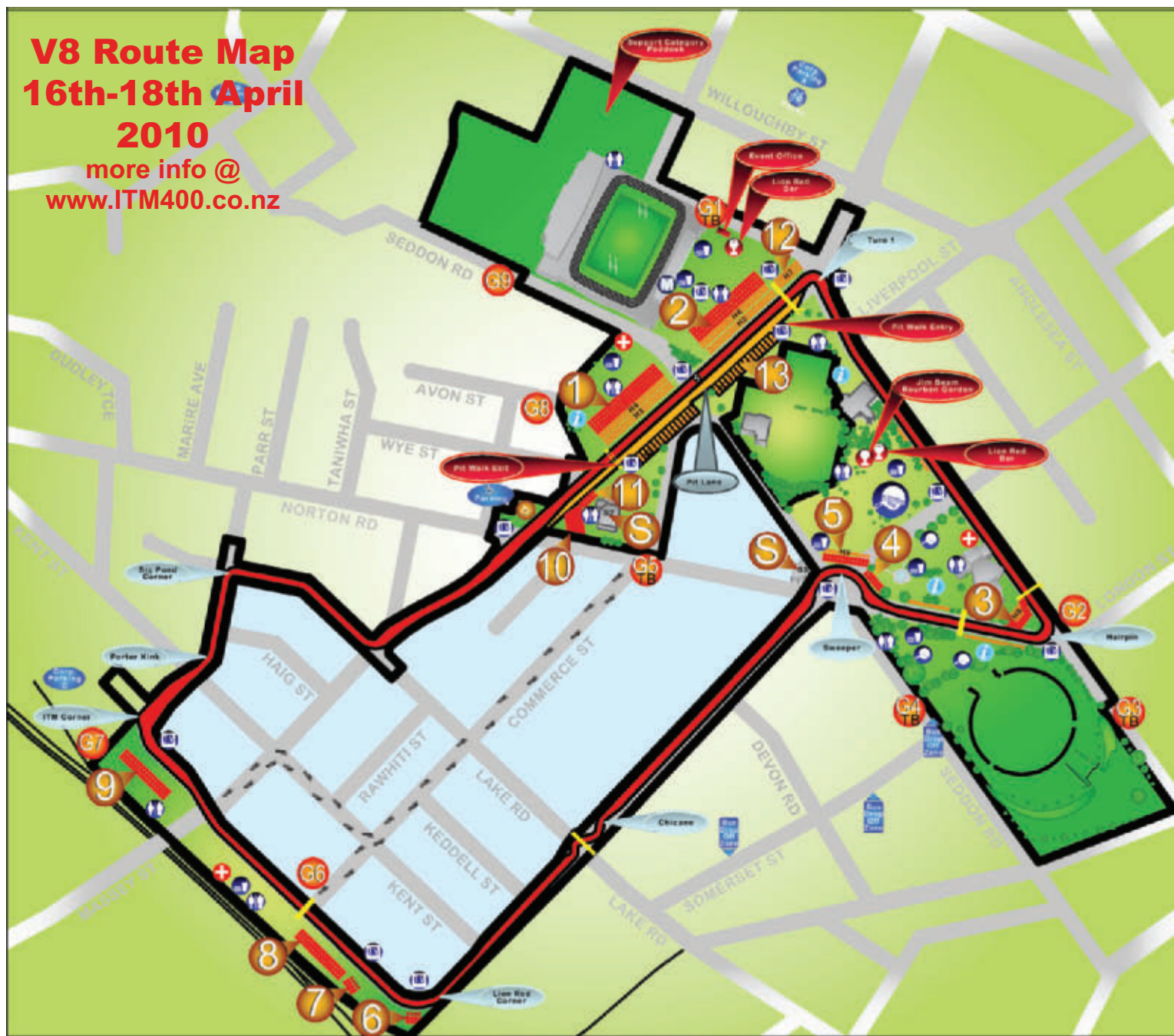

Transportation to the V8 Event

Historic Gold Town

Hauraki District

Waihi's story is a rich tapestry woven through with golden tread. It was the lure of gold that brought people to Waihi in numbers in the early 1900s. Today, you can walk right to the edge of Waihi's huge open pit gold mine. Newmont, the current mining company, conducts daily tours of the site, though bookings are essential. The Martha Mine has a history which spans three centuries, from 1878 to the present. Wandering down Seddon St, you will find bronze statues, restored historic buildings and interesting displays depicting Waihi's heritage. Local shops combine old style service with an

eclectic range of goods and the wide selection of cafes and restaurants cater for all tastes. Local walkways include the Pit Rim Walkway, another to the top of Black Hill and from Gilmour Lake a track follows Mill Stream around the base of Union Hill, another historic mining area. Visit the website www.waihi.org.nz for further details.

Karangahake Gorge is another historic gold mining area with spectacular, pristine scenery, swing bridges across the Ohinemuri and Waitawheta Rivers, old mining tunnels (bring a torch and sturdy footwear), bush walks, and if it is summer bring a picnic and your togs as there are numerous swimmingholes. 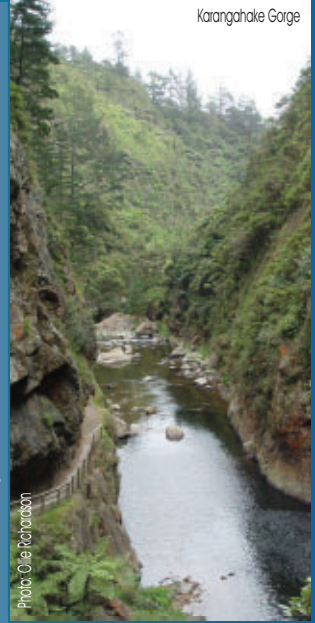

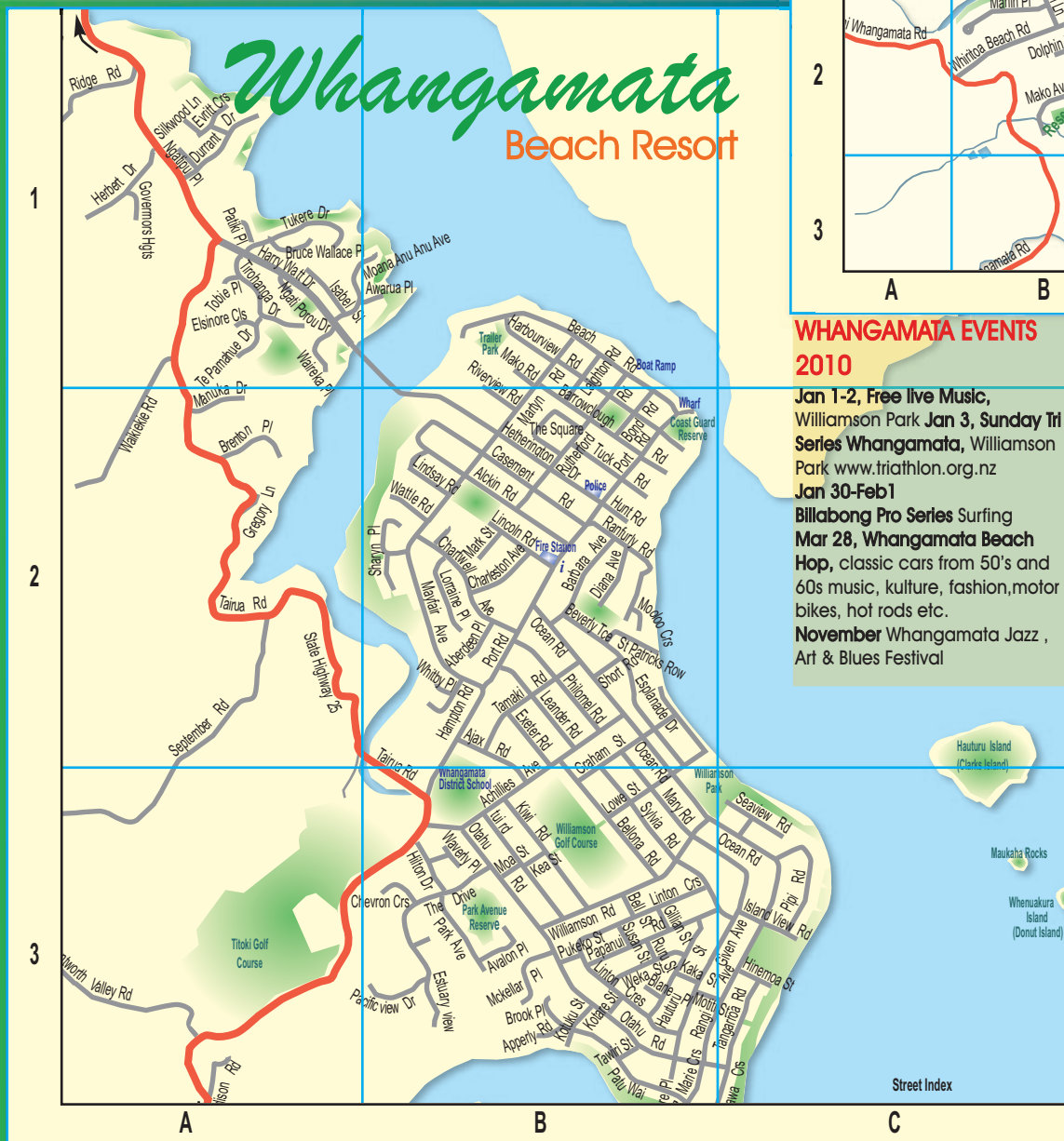

The Lake Hakanoa Walkway:
The Walkway Entrance, Huntly College Native Tree Reserve, Seibu Bunri Gardens - Japanese Garden-, McMillan Walk, WEL Energy Trust Global Gardens, Environment Waikato Wildlife Gardens, Palm Beach, Contemporary Maori Garden, The Green Cathedral - Ponga Grove and The Huntly Domain.

Weavers Park:
400 Metres to the west of the Tainui Bridge in Rotowaro Road, west of Huntly. It is the rehabilitation of the former Weaver's Opencast Mine. 30,000 plants, tracks for walking, cross country, off road running and mountain biking have been established.

The Hakarimata Walkway

Access is via Riverview Road on the west river side of Huntly taking Parker Road on the right hand side where a little further on you will find an extensive car park. 20 minute walk along a metal track to reach the two large Kauris. A further 5 minutes to 'Kauri Grove' where there are over 100 smaller Kauris up to 30m high. A continuation of the main ridge track takes you through to Ngaruawahia.

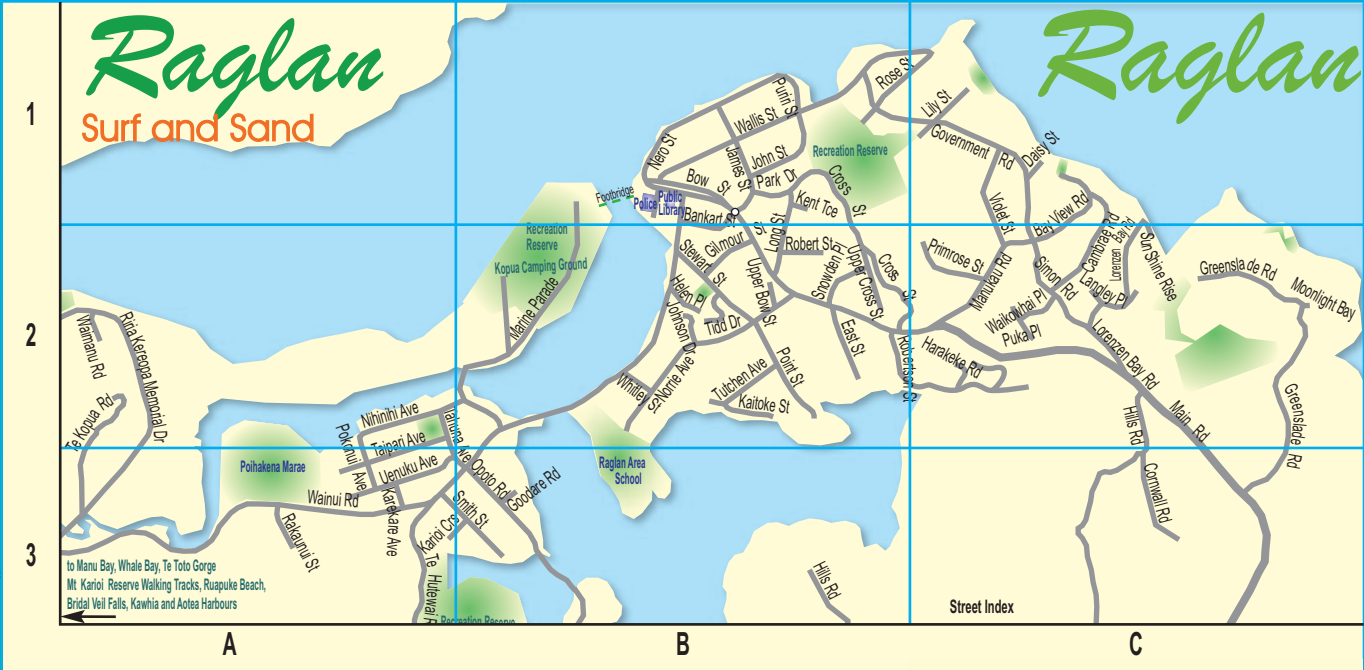

At the northern end of Tirau is the "Big Dog Information Centre". Along side is the large corrugated "Big Sheep Wool Gallery". The rest of Tirau's specialty shops are all within walking distance. Waikato River Trails

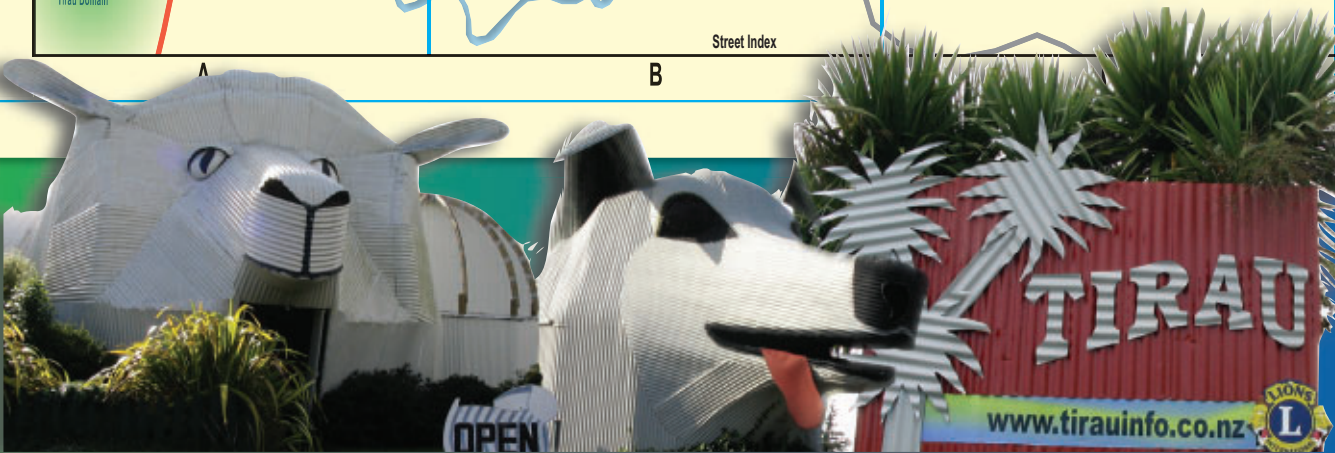
The first part of the trail which runs from Arapuni Dam to Jones landing is 3km in length offering many spectacular views. 1 hour 20 mins each way.

Putaruru Farming and Timber South Waikato

Putaruru has a great variety of walks - long or short - and they all feature the particular beauty of the region. Visitors to Putaruru are invited to wander **Te Waihou Walkway** to view the Blue Springs. The crystal clear spring water is bottled in town, and sold commercially, nationally and beyond, as "Pump" water. In fact, it is this small town that is the source of 60% of New Zealand's bottled water!

Putaruru is based on a history of farming and timber. It is now the commercial centre for some of the most productive dairy farmland in the country and the town's economy is based on this heritage. The Lichfield Dairy Factory - which is one of the newest and largest cheese factories in the world - is only 6km from the town centre.

Putaruru is also host to a national woodturning exhibition - known appropriately as TurNZ - at which some of the most beautiful work in woodturning anywhere in the world can be seen.

Each October and November, in even years, the District holds its Spring Into Summer Festival which combines a wide range of community activities with sporting and cultural events for the three-week festival.

Putaruru Waterpark

The blue colours of the Putaruru Waterpark mimic the colours of Te Waihou spring. Around 5000 plants - all natives - are planted on site. The shape of the feature is similar to the curve of a ponga fern shoot. The Waterpark features two large mosaics. These pieces are extraordinary - both in design and colour and the paving surrounding the WaterPark was contributed by the people of Putaruru. Information from www.swktodc.govt.nz

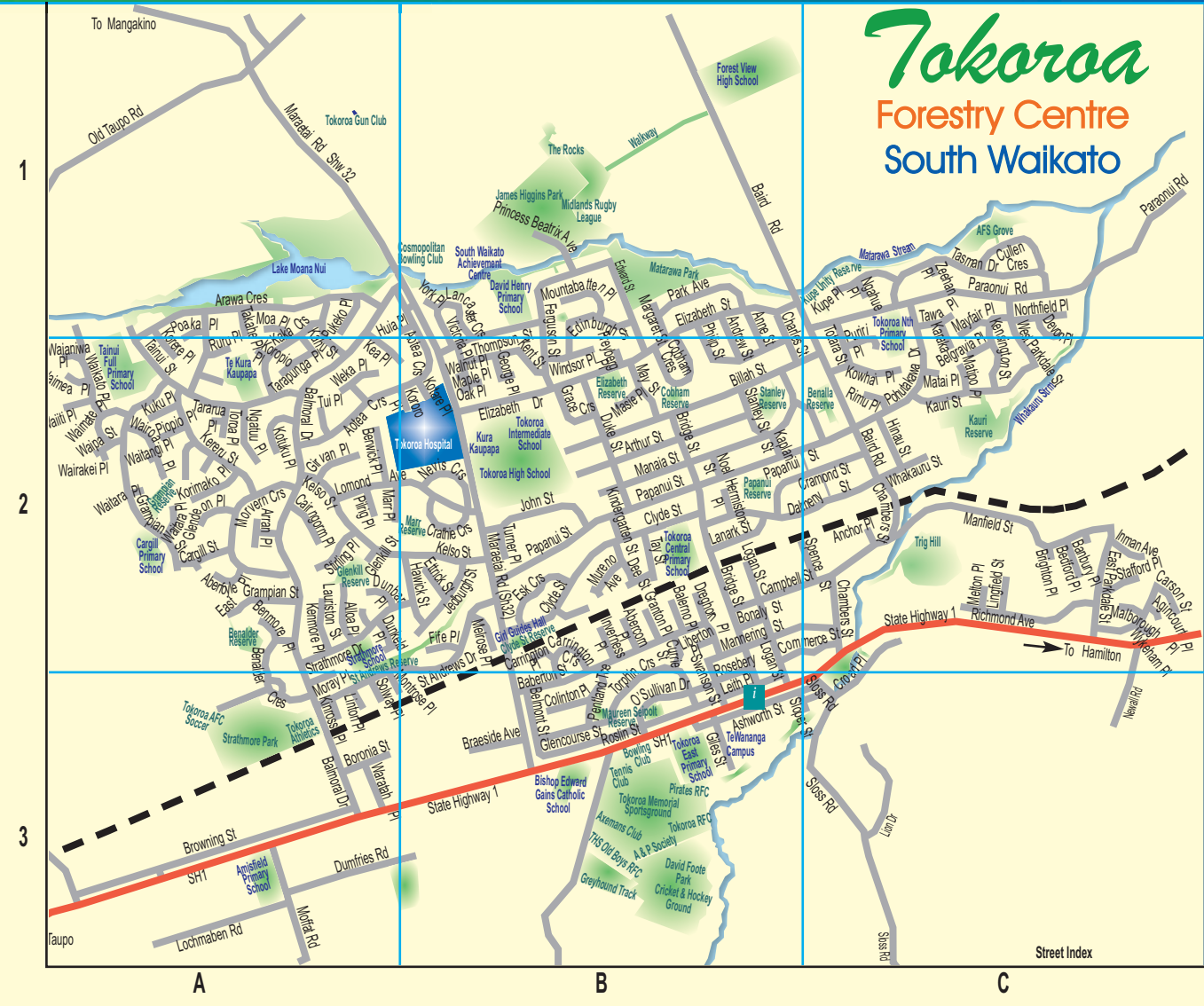

Visit Pokaiwhenua, and Hatupatu rock. Learn of the stories and legends which make these places sacred. Moana-nui, by Matarawa Stream and the scenery from the lookout on Colson's Hill. All year round, visitors to Tokoroa can enjoy easy access to their favourite pastimes and enjoy the special hospitality that makes Tokoroa unique.

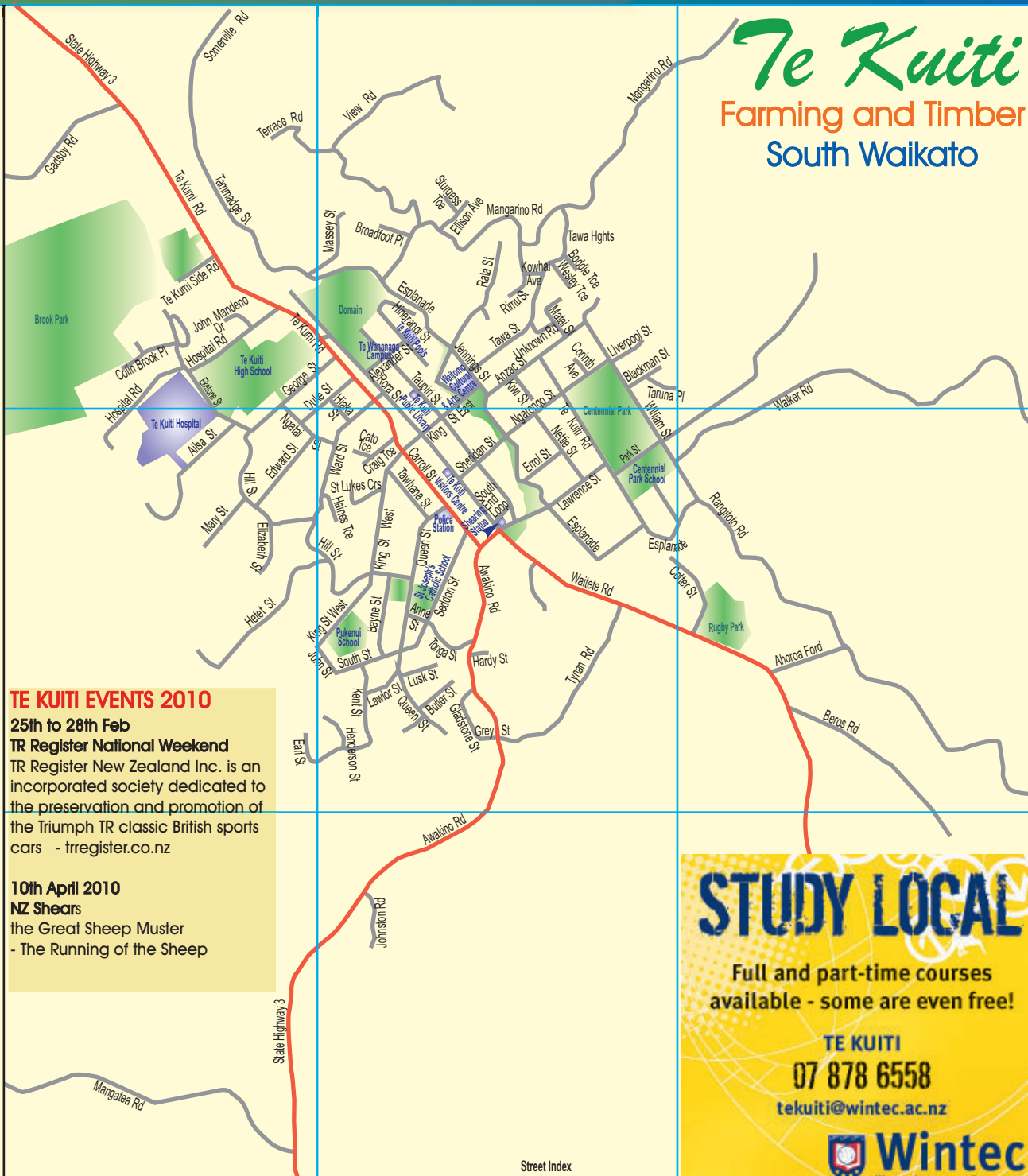

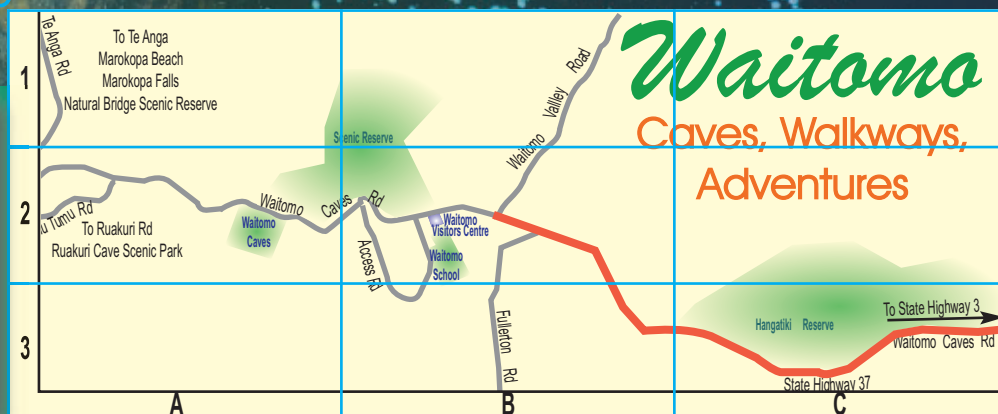
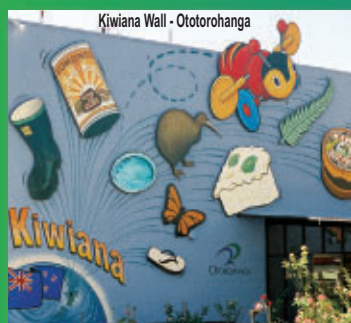
